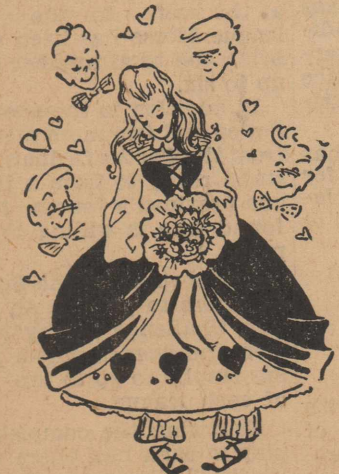

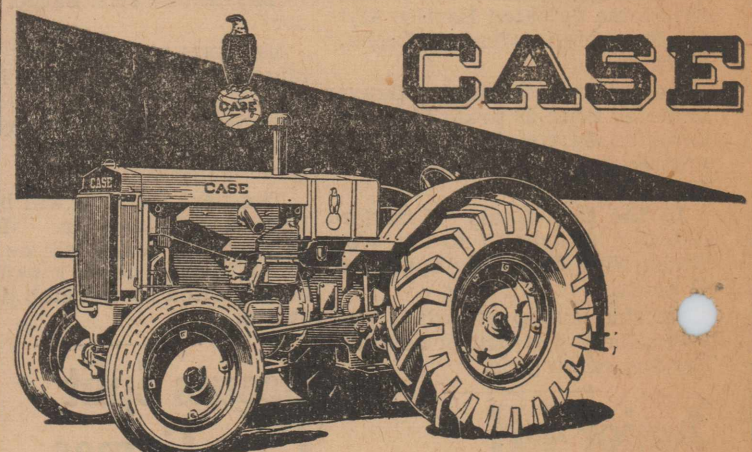



**Home Garden Values Rising**  
 Texans may not realize it, but farm gardens produce a sizable portion of the farm income in the state.

There were approximately 400,000 farm gardens in Texas in 1947, according to an estimate made by J. F. Rosborough, extension horticulturist for Texas A. & M. College. The figure includes gardens up to an acre in size. The value of the vegetables and fruits produced, including those processed for home use as well as fresh for the table, averaged \$110 per garden. That figures out to a total income from the gardens of \$44,000,000.

"Cotton and wheat, the two crops that we figure make the most money, actually brought in an income only a little over eleven times, in the case of cotton, and about six times, in the case of wheat, that of the value of the gardens," Rosborough says. The value of the gardens was over ten times that of flaxseed, an up and coming crop in the southern part of the state.

According to a recent report from the USDA's bureau of Agricultural Economics office in Austin, sorghum for grain, cotton-

seed, corn and sorghum for forage, and rice follow cotton and wheat in income value, in that order. Using Rosborough's figures, the income from farm gardens ranks just below rice, and above peanuts, oats, hay (all kinds), flaxseed, and truck crops.

As a result of the higher costs of food, and in answer to the government's request for an increase in gardens in 1948, Texans will probably come close to doubling last year's garden figures, Rosborough says. If the weather is favorable, the other money-making crops in the state will have to "step lively" to stay ahead of farm gardens.

opment. The entomologists recommend a mixture of three parts of ethylene dichloride to one part carbon tetrachloride as the ideal fumigant for killing insect pests in stored grain. It won't burn or explode, but it is a poison gas and care must be taken not to inhale its fumes. The grain must be stored in tight cribs or bins, and a garden-type sprayer is best for making the application. Spray the liquid thoroughly and evenly over the grain at the rate of 6 to 8 gallons for a thousand

bushels. A commercial mixture of carbon disulphide-carbon tetrachloride is also effective. It's a good idea, the entomologists say, to check stored grain on a monthly basis. If insect infestation and damage is found, fumigate promptly.

years have brought the discovery and successful use of sulfa drugs and penicillin in treating the disease and reducing the high scores of deaths which it formerly caused. At the same time, if pneumonia is allowed to go untreated, it is as great a menace to life as it ever was.

There are various types of pneumonia, brought on by different causes, but they are all a disease of the lungs and they all may cause serious complications. Pneumonia germs are fast-growing and destructive and they produce poisons that invade the blood stream and other areas of the body. For these reasons, no matter how soon it is detected and treatment begun, pneumonia has already done serious damage. Early treatment may shorten the course of the disease itself, but the poisons may remain for a time afterward and the patient's convalescence must be carefully supervised.

Typical symptoms of pneumonia include severe chill, fever, coughing with expectoration, sometimes with rust colored sputum and pains in the chest or side. The disease develops rapidly and the patient's breathing becomes heavy and difficult. If pneumonia is suspected and the patient has a fever he should remain in bed and the doctor should be called immediately.

Anything that tends to reduce the vitality of the body, especially during the winter months, makes it easier for pneumonia to attack. Loss of sleep, an inadequate diet, exposure to cold and wet weather, extreme fatigue and untreated colds are all invitations to the invasion of the disease. Because pneumonia germs grow and spread so rapidly, a strong healthy body has the best chance of fighting them successfully. A patient already weakened by exposure to bad weather

er or unhealthful excesses of any kind has little to combat the invasion of pneumonia germs.

Sufficient rest and care during the period of convalescence are extremely important. There is no known way to produce immunity to the disease. One attack does not set up immunity. On the contrary, pneumonia frequently recurs.

Success with sulfa drugs and penicillin in treating pneumonia is no reason to relax our guard against the disease. It is still one of the most widespread and fatal of all acute diseases, and its early detection and treatment can still mean the difference between life and death.
