## Instructions For Cleaning Ladies Gloves

If you have been wondering how to care for your gloves follow these easy directions.
Gloves of suede, capeskin, p gSkin and doeskin often are finished so they can be washed "ome. Be sure they are labeled "washable," however, before try-
ing to launder them, states Miss Lorothy Dixon, home demonstration agent. Kid and some diy cleaned. Here are the diy

Sudsing: Use a mild soap or a synthetic detergent and lukearm water. Put gluves on and wash them as you would your
hand. Lather gloves well but con't scub. Use a soft brush on tingertips or badly soiled places.
kinsing: Take off wet gloves, boins vareful not to tear or stretch them. Run lukewarm
water through them. (This help $p$ ish gloves into shape.) Fur pigskin acid a couple of drops of glycerin to rinse water to sorten and press out the water, but do not wring.

Drying: Lay gloves flat on a dry towel or hang over a towel on line. Do not hang by clothespins; they will leave marks. Dry slowly at room temperature, too much heat may harm the leataer. When g.oves are nearly dy,
work them gently to make leathwork them gently
For washing fabric gloves follow the same procedure. Omit the last step ing and drying will washing, rinsing, and arying will new.
