Slight Increase In Local Tax Allocation

While it isn't unusual for the City of Littlefield to top the list of area communities in the amount of its monthly sales tax reimbursement, or to top the list in the percentage of increase, this month's

totals from Texas State Comptroller's office shows a particularly large increase. This month, Littlefield's sales tax allocation — which represents money collected by merchants in October and reported to the state in November,

has increased by 62.39 percent compared to the amount received during the same period last year. In comparison, Farwell, which had an increase of 23.89 percent, and Muleshoe's allocation was up 2.92 percent.

According to the state totals, Littlefield merchants collected \$40,908.08 more for this month's allocation. Farwell merchants collected \$1,729.03 more during the same period, and Muleshoe merchants.

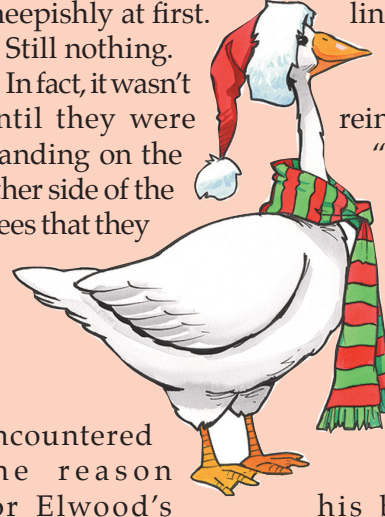
Santa's Christmas Gift

Unarmed America Is Not The Answer

Editorial

"Powerful lobbying groups allow the ownership of guns to reach beyond the Constitution's intended purpose of the right to bear arms. Therefore, Congress must act on what is stated law, and face the reality that access to firearms reaches beyond what the Second Amendment intends to achieve..."

With such words, gun control advocates in Washington, DC, have petitioned the President to take action in the wake of the terrible tragedy Friday in Newtown, Conn.

And while all the nation gasps in horror at the actions of this madman who reportedly murdered a

family member before attacking some of the smallest and weakest members of our society, we find ourselves slack jawed over the petitioner's statement, seriously wondering if they have any actual knowledge about the intent and purpose of the Second Amendment to the US Constitution.

At the time this editorial was initiated, we had yet to know exactly how the weapons used came into the gunman's possession.

Since that time, we have learned that — as was the case of the recent shooter in the Oregon shopping mall, the weapons were stolen, which suggests that the intent of restricting legal firearms purchases, as expressed in the aforementioned petition, is about as sound as the US economy in the face of the "fiscal cliff."

Within the legislative halls and high courts of this nation there have been enormous amounts of misinformation piled upon the Second Amendment, all part of the orchestrated effort to silence its intent and devalue its purpose.

By suggesting that the Second Amendment protects the rights of "state military institutions," gun

control advocates have chipped away at the rights and freedoms expressed within the Bill of Rights — each of which were aimed at protecting the "individual" rights of those citizens who having experienced the governmental excesses of Great Britain sought assurance that this newest experiment in nationalism would not lose sight of those who fought, bled and died setting it in place.

At the same time, defenses of the amendment that suggest its roots rest in the longstanding traditions of the hunting field are of limited accuracy as well.

The decreasing opportunities and participation in such activities carries with it a decrease in the need for such protections.

Which leaves the reason... the foundation, upon which our forefathers based its inclusion in those initial amendments dedicated to protecting the rights of the individual.

Such a statement flies in the very face of what the Second Amendment

"intends to achieve." Our forefathers intent was to assure the citizenry of this nation that it would always retain the right, and its ability, to safeguard its own rights from the government which they were at that time forming, and which continues to this day.

It is truly sad that such events as has recently occurred have occurred, but as will always be the case, it is the mind behind the trigger finger that is the problem and not the tools utilized.

Sadly, on the same day as the horror in Connecticut, a man armed with a knife attached and injured a similar number of students in China.

Does something need to be done to prevent future attacks? Obviously, but disarming members of the "mentally stable" general public does nothing more than increase targets of opportunity for such madmen.

Have you ever thought there might be a reason why such incidents normally occur at locations which either by choice or statute prohibit the presence of licensed and equipped concealed handgun carriers?

I just hugged my five-year-old granddaughter a bit longer even than usual. She doesn't know anything about what happened last week at Newtown, Connecticut.

She doesn't need to know. I wish I didn't. The media had a duty to tell us; I doubt they have a duty to wallow in it.

On one Sunday just before Christmas several years ago, I found myself gazing at the front of the sanctuary and watching silhouetted shepherds themselves gazing upward in wonder, one of them pointing toward a brightly shining star just feet away from the arrangement of three crosses also displayed before us.

It was a poignant reminder that in God's wisdom Bethlehem and Golgotha are forever linked, two sides of the same amazing story of God's love.

drawing his first breath of air in the world he had spun into existence eons before was more than a baby. He was Immanuel, God with us, God in the flesh, God who came into this world laying aside the robes of royalty, willingly clothing himself in humanity to fully experience our joys and our sorrows, our triumphs and our tears.

I love the story told by author John Drescher about a little boy lying awake terrified by a storm one night. From his dark shadowy room he cries out to his father, "Daddy, come, I'm scared."

Daddy replies, "Oh, son, God loves you and he'll take care of you."

But the boy isn't satisfied, and he shouts

back, "I know God loves me and that he'll take care of me, but right now I need somebody with skin on."

Our world did, too. And so God came "with skin on." Immanuel. God with us. God sharing fully in the human situation from "the trauma of birth to the violence of death." God feeling everything a human being can feel.

Christmas assures me that the God I worship is no absentee landlord who lives a million miles away leaving the poor tenants to aimlessly "do their own thing."

Nor is our God a heavenly bureaucrat lost somewhere on a cloud shuffling paper and handing down rules to complicate a situation he knows nothing about.

God is not the sort of military officer who proposes daring offensives but has never led a charge from anywhere more dangerous than a warm command post where he might fall off a chair as he sits safely moving markers and flags around on a map.

Christmas assures me that God has been at the front. He's seen the blood. And the most precious of all was his own Son's who died so that one day death itself will die.

The wondrous story of Christmas is that with those stunned shepherds, all the angels and the universe itself watched awestruck at the depth of God's love as he became what we needed most — Immanuel, God with skin on.

When in this twisted world, a madman tries to "out-Herod" Herod and more innocents die, a "God with skin on" who fully shares our pain and our tears is the God we need — and the God we have.

Bethlehem's manger and Golgotha's cross. A "God with skin on" gives them both meaning. And gives us hope through our tears.

Last week, Mrs. April Smith, our Muleshoe High School Business and Computer teacher, heard about the need for volunteers to help bake cookies for the more than 700 single airmen stationed at Cannon Air Force Base.

Isaias Salas will also

graduate this Friday at a special ceremony at our PEP Alternative Campus.

City Council Acts On Red Cross...

Continued from A1 cooperation agreement will allow the city and Red Cross to coordinate information and pool some resources.

"What's spelled out in this (agreement) is that we would do because the need to be done," Brunson said.

"This formalizes an agreement with the national Red Cross and the Red Cross in this

district," he added.

The agreement also assures Red Cross representatives that space will be available to them in the city's emergency operation center.

"We're not going to make them stand out in the cold, unless we're standing out in the cold," Brunson said.

In other business, the council:

- Held a work session to learn how to use the iPads™ that have been purchased to allow the city to reduce its paper usage.

- Approved a resolution suspending the effective date between SPS/Xcel Energy and the coalition of municipal governments — Alliance of Xcel Municipalities, of which Muleshoe is a member. The city manager is also a member of the coalition's steering committee.

According to Brunson, the energy company has requested a rate increase that will generate about \$90 million more for SPS.

The resolution will allow the alliance to negotiate with the company for a more reasonable rate increase.

- Approved the minutes from the city's Nov. 12 meeting.

- Received an administration report

in which the city manager noted that the city's newest water well is capable of producing 350 gallons per minute, and that with all of its wells in operation the city has access to four million gallons per day of potable water.

Brunson added that during the hottest part of last summer, the city was using about two million gallons a day — only half of the available capacity.

Brunson also remembered that when he originally came to Muleshoe, the city had far fewer wells and only had a total capacity of about 117 percent.

In other words, the city was only capable of producing 17 percent more water than was needed.

"That was pretty scary," he added.

This month, the bottom of the list was held by Sudan, the only area community with a drop in drop in sales tax collections, at -3.60 percent compared to last years totals, representing a drop of \$143.20.

In year-to-date totals, Littlefield continues to hold a commanding lead, with a 19.95 percent increase from 2011 totals.

In actual dollars, Littlefield has collected \$1,098,919,55 this year, compared to the \$916,12.87 it had collected at this time last year.

Muleshoe falls seventh when looking at its percentage of increase for the year — representing an increase of 3.58 percent or \$19,178.70.

The smallest Y-T-D increase is Bovina, which sets at -2.08 percent, representing a \$1,964.09 decrease in sales tax collected.

According to Texas Comptroller Susan Combs, state sales tax revenue in November 2012 was \$2.34 billion, up 13.1 percent compared to November 2011.

"Gains across major sectors boosted state

sales tax revenue," Combs said in a recent news release. "Collections were strong in sectors such as retail trade, manufacturing, oil and natural gas, construction and telecommunications."

Combs will send December local sales tax allocations totaling \$552 million to cities, counties, transit systems and special purpose taxing districts, up 15.5 percent compared to December 2011.

Muleshoe School Board Discusses 'Poaching Problem'

"The superintendent, Joanna Martinez, said they weren't trying to get students from Muleshoe... that they were only trying to promote their district to families in their district," he added, later suggesting that argument didn't seem very practical.

In response to Martinez' reply, Dr. Sheets said he recommended a billboard out on Hwy. 214 by Clay's Corner, within the Lazbuddie school district seemed more appropriate.

"I think most all of their families pass by that intersection almost every day," he said.

In addition, the Muleshoe superintendent said, Lazbuddie is running a school bus well into the Muleshoe ISD district to transport Muleshoe students to Lazbuddie schools.

The activities, along with Lazbuddie ISD "incorrectly" posting its TEA status as being "recognized" on its website for the past two years, instead of LISD's actual "acceptable" rating, suggests the

neighboring school district is actively trying to recruit Muleshoe students.

"On their required postings, they have the 2009-2010 AEIS report, instead of the 2010-2011 report, which shows they are "acceptable," he added.

According to Dr. Sheets, this rating information appears to be the only information on the LISD website that appears to be misleading.

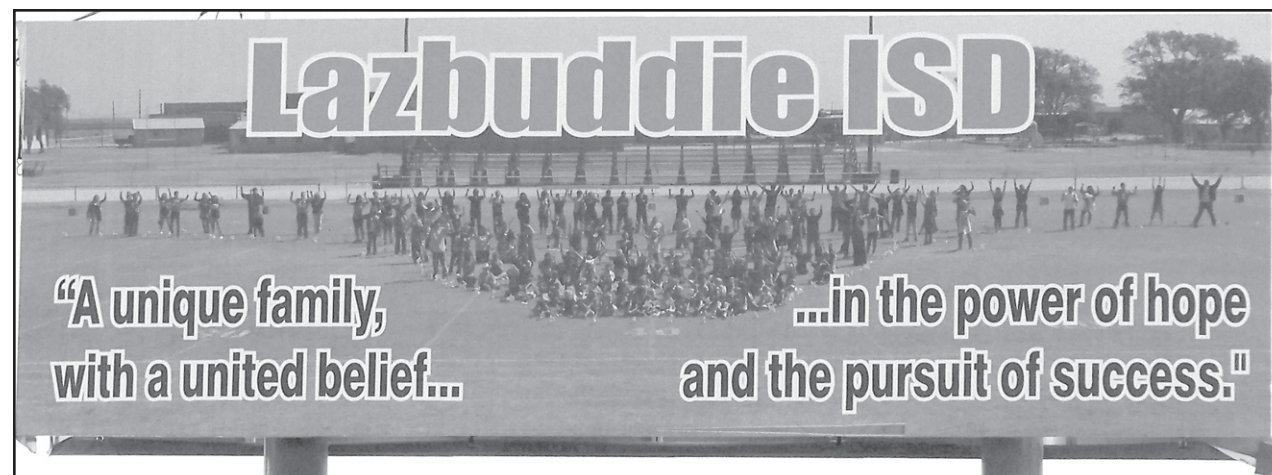
"The rest of their website looks to be up to date," he said.

"Their superintendent told me that they would talk to me at the end of this school year about whether or not they would continue running a bus into our school district next year," Sheets said.

"I've been approached many times by people who have asked about the Lazbuddie billboard," board member Carrol Precure said, adding that many of those people are offended by it.

"There's no gentleman's agreement between school districts?" asked board member Daniel Guzman.

"There use to be."

"The Farwell School District is also running a school bus into our school district," said Dr. Sheets, who having graduated from Farwell High School has always maintained a close relationship with FISD.

After watching a Farwell bus drop off a student at a local business, Sheets said he contacted the FISD superintendent, requesting that practice be stopped.

Sheets added that the FISD school board met last week and discussed the issue, and would put it on the agenda for the January meeting.

"I am hopeful that the Farwell school board will decide to stop driving their bus into our district," Sheets said.

"I graduated from Farwell High School. I learned to treat others as I wanted to be treated in Farwell, and I'm confident that once the Farwell School Board considers this in that light, that they would stop their bus from coming into the Muleshoe School District," he added.

"If they don't, is it possible for Muleshoe to promote itself in their districts?" board member Sergio Leal asked.

"We've had requests for us to drive into their

school districts, and we haven't done that," Sheets said.

"Two wrongs don't make it right," board member Jay Cage pointed out, and while he said he thinks what LISD and FISD are doing is wrong, he's uncertain about returning the favor and recruiting in the other districts in the same manner.

"I'd still like emphasize the positive," Precure said. "I think we have a lot going for us here."

It was also noted that Farwell's school district had also misidentified itself as a recognized district for the past two years. However, this has reportedly been changed recently.

In other business, the school board recognized the achievements of the varsity Mules football team, including the student trainers, for their Bi-District championship win.

"They represented us very well on the field, and off the football field," Dr. Sheets said.

HPWD Reminds Well Owners Of Recording Period

High Plains Water District rule amendments require flow meter readings or readings from alternative measuring methods to be recorded between Dec. 15 and Jan. 15 of each year.

This information is needed to report annual groundwater use from the Ogallala Aquifer to the district by March 1 of the following year.

The Water District encourages owners/operators of certain water wells or well systems to make readings to determine their ending meter readings for 2012 groundwater use reporting. The ending point for 2012 will be the starting point for 2013 reporting.

On-line reporting of meter readings or alternative measuring methods is available by clicking on the "Log Meter Entries Here" button on the right

side of the HPWD web site (www.hpwd.com). The meter site is also available directly at map.hpwd.com.

"We encourage groundwater users to complete the following steps on-line during the December 15-January 15 reporting period," said Field Data Collection Supervisor Gerald Crenwelge.

"This meter module is a secure site where persons may create a user account, associate owners/properties with the user account, plot the location of the meter or alternative measuring method on National Agricultural Imagery Program (NAIP) aerial images, and update information about the meter installation. Even if you haven't entered any information until now — you can still do it at this time," he said.

Alternative measuring

methods may be used for existing wells in lieu of flow meters during the transitional period from Jan. 1, 2012 to Dec. 31, 2015. The three approved alternative measuring methods include electricity consumption, natural gas consumption, and nozzle packages/hour meter readings on center pivot systems.

Groundwater users wanting to "bank" the unused portion of their 2012 allowable production must enter data into the on-line database.

"Readings from either a metered well/well system or alternative measuring method can be used in calculating the amount of water that is eligible for banking in the future. This information must be entered in the on-line meter module so that the database can automatically make calculations.

Groundwater users can enter data themselves or HPWD personnel can assist them," Crenwelge said.

He added that all measuring methods (meter or alternative method) are treated equally in the database.

Groundwater users need to have accurate beginning/ending meter or alternative measuring method readings so that the database can make proper calculations.

It is important to note that the reporting requirements do not apply to wells producing less than 17.5 gallons of water per minute (25,000 gallons per day) OR wells solely for domestic use (even if they produce more than 17.5 gallons per minute). However, wells that are part of a well system that has a total aggregated capacity to produce more than 17.5 gallons of water per

minute (25,000 gallons per day) are included.

"A video tutorial on the new site offers instruction on how to complete the meter reporting process. Plus,

persons may also stop by the HPWD office or contact us at (806) 762-0181. Staff members are available to assist persons in setting up their on-line account.

Tales Of Christmas Past In Texas

"We just got up on Christmas morning... and we'd usually have an apple and orange in our stockings. That was about the only time we ever had oranges. I can smell an orange to this day, and it always makes me think of Christmas. We didn't get many toys. We got necessities."

This was a Christmas memory of Zulieka O'Daniel, who was born in 1911 and was raised on a farm southwest of Hart.

Zulieka's Christmas mornings were much the same for many other Texas children in the early 1900s. While the settings were simple and the gifts limited, Christmas inspired the same anticipation and excitement then that it does for children today.

Elora Riddle, who lived on a farm to the west of Kress, recalled that her older siblings traveled into town by buggy to purchase surprise Christmas gifts one year for the younger children in the family.

"Lucindy and Elbert went to town and it snowed and they couldn't get back on Christmas Eve. We hung our stockings on Christmas Eve and Papa and Mama put an orange and an apple, nuts and candy in, so we had that for Christmas and we thought that was all we were going to get."

The morning after Christmas, Elora went to the breakfast table to



find a "celluloid doll" at her place at the table. "We were so happy that Santa came back," she said.

In 1920, a third-grader by the name of Mill Boyd of Dumas attended a community Christmas celebration at her schoolhouse. Instead of individual Christmas celebrations at home, the entire community would gather at the schoolhouse and Santa would visit all of Dumas' children at once.

Mill left that year's gathering in delight, carting home with her a "wicker doll buggy and a Schoenhut doll."

According to Mill, the Schoenhut dolls were hand-carved, German-made dolls who were "jointed and had real hair."

In addition to the doll and buggy, Mill also received two boxes of chocolates from her "little boyfriend" that year.

Her mother was not pleased and told Mill she was too young to receive the chocolates and would have to return them.

Mill's father, however, interjected, "Leave her alone now. I'm gonna eat that candy."

An even earlier Christmas recollection in 1863 by the daughter of former Texas Governor E.M. Pease, Julia, included a description of the family Christmas tree: "Not tall and stately as the German Tannenbaum, but just a common cedar."

Julia recalled that the ladies of the household spent the weeks leading up to Christmas preparing the trimmings for the tree, including stringing popcorn.

Julia noted that because of the Civil War, goods had been blockaded from the North and all food and clothing that year had to be made at home.

In the 1890s, Mrs. W.H. Thaxton of Onion Creek told the Austin American-Statesman that "real" eggnog was served in "liberal portions" among her family and the neighbors at Christmas.

She also noted that "all laws, short of murder and arson,

were suspended for the time, and many were the mutual misunderstandings that were settled at Christmastime."

At the end of Christmas day, "dancing was engaged in, and the nights were enlivened by the merry strains of the fiddle (not violin), and the calls of the prompter as merrily the dance went on far into the night."

Today, as many of us find ourselves caught up in the hustle and bustle of the holiday season, there is something to be said about the simplicity of Christmas past in Texas.

May we all take the time to enjoy the small things, the time together with family and friends, and the real meaning of the season.

From my family to yours: Merry Christmas, happy holidays and best wishes for a safe and prosperous New Year.

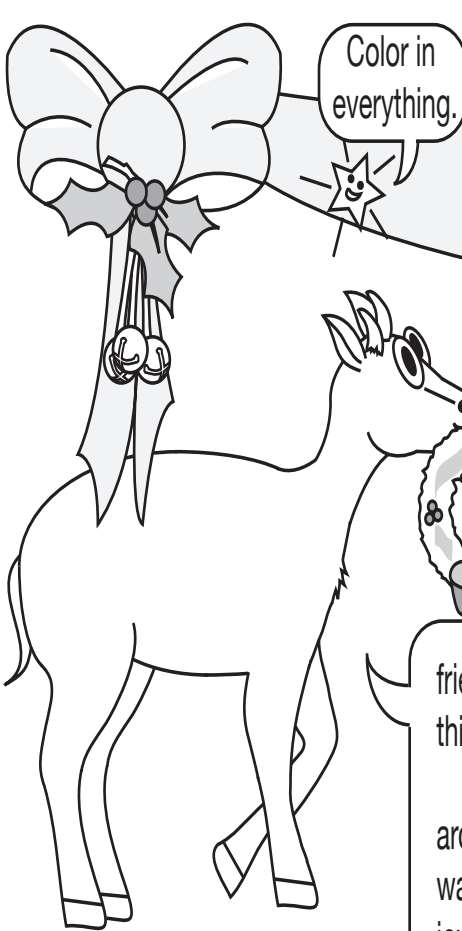

The Mules continued to battled back despite falling behind by 11 points in the first quarter and 10 points twice in the second period.

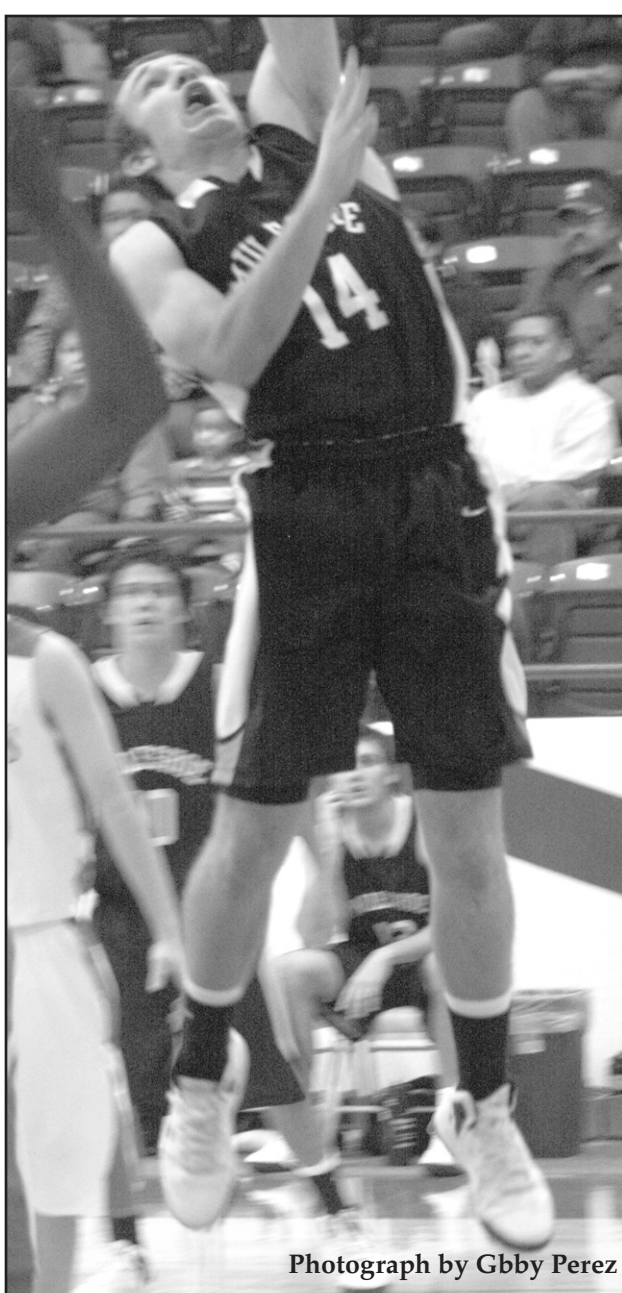
The score was tied at 53-53 when the buzzer sounded. The Mules out scored the Whirlwinds 10-6 in the over time period for the 63-59 win.
