# THANKSGIVING <br> Shall We Pass It Up This Year? 

Sivi the days of the Pilgrim Fathers, Thanksgiving has been an occasion of gratitude and joy. The day was set apart for pause and reflection - to celebrate a plentiful harvest - to enjoy the feeling of security, peace and contentment that are the honest rewards of an able and industrious people.

## But What of Thanksgiving, 1933?

So many of the desirable things - the blessings that we took for granted as justly ours - seem to have vanished from our midst.
