Texas wheat growers are in high spirits. Condition of the crop on May 1, 1934, was reported at 56 per cent of nor-
mal compared with 48 per cent a year ago, and 75 per cent
for the 10 -year averape. Approximately $4,000,000$ acres
were sown in wheat last fall. Abandonment leaves $2,861,000$
for harvest this year. An average yield of nine bushels per
acre is indicated by the state bureau of the United States
bureau of agriculture, or a total yield this year of $25,749,000$ bushels. Prices paid Texas farmers for wheat increased from
42 cents per bushel in 1933 to 66 cents this year, as of March 15 ; for corn 36 cents to 64 cents; for oats 22 cents to 42 .
