GENEVA, Dec. 13-Emperor Haile Selassie's demand that the League assembly be called into session to condemn the Franco-British peace plan was rejected today, for the time being at least, by the president,

Edouard Benes of Czechoslovakia. The emperor's appeal to the League carried a clear intimation that he never would accept the plan involving proposed cedings of some of his territory to Italy.

Replying to the Ethiopian emperor. Benes said that inasmuch as the league council composed of representatives of major powers would examine the proposal Wednesday, there was no need at this ime to summons the assembly.
