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Elwin Skiles Sees Making of Pontiac

PONTIAC, Mich., May 11—How Pontiac cars are built was witnessed at first hand today by Mr. E. L. Skiles, son of Mr. A. I. Skiles of Cisco, Texas, who was a visitor at the Pontiac factories here. Mr. Skiles spent several hours going through the plants under the direction of a guide who explained the various processes in automobile manufacture as each manufacturing department was visited.
One of the most interesting points according to Mr. Skiles, was the final assembly plant where the complete assembling of the car, from the frame to the finished automobile is to be seen. Here the shining new cars taken from under the visitor's eyes and roll off the end of the final assembly line at the rate of one a minute.
The huge forge plant, where giant machines forge out crankshafts, cams and other parts, and the sheet metal division in which fenders and other sheet metal parts are stamped out on huge presses and costly dies, were among other impressive sights, Mr. Skiles said.
