## The Revenue-Raising Myth

-In state after state, once pari-mutuel gambling is legalized, the unhappy trut is that horse and dog racing brings in less than $1 \%$ of any state's revenue. Texa tate budget analysts predict that after five years of racing, dog and horse track $1 / 2$ of $1 \%$ of the state's current $\$ 192$ billion annual budget needs.
