Many of us have probably
heard stories about a time when there was very little one of the major problems on rangeland is brush Brush docs several things
which make itapest

producers. Brush develops a
canopy which keeps sunlight from reaching the desirable plants thus reducing their growth and palatability. Brush also competes with grass for the precious water.
There are stories of streams which flowed for years which stopped flowing after the
brush invaded the banks of the stream. When the brush the stream. When the brush
was removed the stream almost immediately began to flow again. With the brush kept down the stream has continued toflow year round. There are three major meth-
ods of brush management: Chemical, mechanical and iological. The method to be
sed is a personal preference used is a personal
