|  | Well folks, it finally happened! The farm bill got thru both houses before harvest time. That's enough to convince the most skeptical that Congress can "act" if it gets its mind made up. This farm bill took up one full "Special session" and only a couple of months on another regular session. <br> The farm bill as finally passed did not take away our Sudan grazing privileges in the Southwest. The fact that this privilege remains with us will make it lots easier for farmers in this area to stay in the farm program. The fact is, only a few farmers could afford to "stay in" if sudan were taken out. <br> The details and workings of the new farm legislation haven't as yet been worked out. We feel sure that in a very short time a list of the "cans" and "cants" will be forwarded to the field for our information and guidance.
