"Liberty Tree" commemorative stamped postal envelopes are now being sold at the post offices. <br> The bicentennial pecan is called a liberty tree after the elm in colonial Boston, where the first act of public resistance occurred in 1765 , the hanging in effigy of a stamp tax officer.
