Saturday Night Is
Now Recovering
R. S. Brooks merchant at Progress
who was hi-jacked about one o'clock Saturday morning, is reported re eoverng from. his wound and able to
be up ain. He was struck over the
head with. a revolver while examining About one q'clock, Saturday mornin Brocks was hailed from bed by a
man who claimed his car was out of
gas and he waitted some more. Putheld four gathons he became somewhat
suspicious. He was asked to examine
the oil in the car and durin ed to have been previously take. alleg-
ing the same night in a Bovina hard-
ing Brooks grappled with the robber who
succeeded in getting away and jumpsucceeded in getting away and jump-
ed into the car where another man
and woman were in waiting and made good his escape. Brooks was able to
get into the house and secure his own
gun tut the hi-fackers by that time were out of range. There was a big bump raised on
Brooks head from the blow of the
