## Resort in Egypt limits swimming after shark attacks kill one tourist

SHARM EL-SHEIKH, Egypt
(AP) - Egypt kept most of the 30-mile Egypt kept most of the 30 -mile coastline off the Red Sea resort of Sharm El-Sheikh closed to of shark attacks killed ane European the past week.
Authorities diverted novice divers to the closest major resort, Dahab, about 50 miles ( 80 kilometers) north of Sharm. They reopened the waters off Sharm to experienced divers,
except for a 2 -mile stretch where except for a 2 -mile stretch where
the shark attacks occurred. Three spots were designated for swimmers and snorkelers - mostly closed bays, mangroves and a national park. A team of U.S. experts arrived to help investigate the unusual series of attacks in one of the world's top
diving destinations. diving destinations.
Sharm el-Sheikh is a major Egyptian tourist attraction, with a busy
airport that brings in package tours from Europe and offers a warm and quick escape from frigid winter temperatures on the continent. Divers are drawn by the steep drop-offs of coral eefs just offshore that offer deep walls of coral with a rich and colorful sea view wild sharks.
Shark attacks in the area are rare and authorities were scrambling to prevent them from cutting into the crucial revenues that Red Sea tourism brings to Egypt.

Ways to avoid stressing out
-Eat a well-balanced diet

- Get 8 hours of sleep
- Only worry about things you can control
- Study as much as you can before the final, don't try to prepare at the last minute
What to do if you get stressed
-Pay attention to your thought patterns. All people have thought patterns that make them more anxious.
-Do not overgeneralize. Example: "I always do poorly on these tests."
-Do not blow things out of proportion. "If | do badly on this test my life is ruined."
-Do not use demanding words. "I have to pass this test."
-Do not make assumptions about what other people are thinking. "My instructor wants me to fail this class."

Schedule a time for breaking. If studying 30 minutes is a long time for you, break after 45. Do something you enjoy.

-Slow down,
close your eyes and take a deep breath, ignoring distractions.
-Focus on your breath and relax all of your muscles, starting with your feet and working up your body. - If you feel tense all over, practice tensing up your muscles, then relaxing them. -Say mental boost phrases to yourself such as, "I know this material." Or, "Do the best you can."
