## Eight hostages released; U.S. bombs hideout

IRAQ ACTIVITY: Italian aid workers released while American forces attack militant area.

BAGHDAD, Iraq (AP) - Two kidnapped Italian aid workers were freed Tuesday after three weeks of captivity in Iraq, and six other hostages in the country also were released. American forces bombed a suspected militant hide-out in Falluiah, and the military claimed its frequent strikes have taken a toll
