WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bronte, Texas ("City Council"), has been provided with documentation from competent, well recognized medical professionals and law enforcement officials of the growing presence of a new and potentially substance dangerous affecting the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens, particularly the youth of the City of Bronte ("City"); and

WHEREAS, in response to these warnings, the City Council has secured information indicating that this threat is presented in the form of retail products sold or distributed as a mixture of dried vegetation that when covered or mixed with certain specific chemicals, produces the physiological and psychological effects of a controlled substance such as marijuana; and

WHEREAS, the substances identified above are considered to be generally described as synthetic cannabinoids or salvia divinorum which may be distributed, sold and
