OUR FAVORITE CHRISTMAS STORY

(This story was started in last week's NEWS. It was written by the mother of W. L. Boyd of Seminole.)

CHRISTMAS 1916

Automobiles were scarce and we were hoping we would not encounter one on the trip; and we did not. We arrived at Sweetwater the first night and found a place to stop where we could pen our stock. The next morning we got an earlier start and on the night of Christmas Eve were to a little rise just east of Colorado City. We could see the lights twinkling in town as we made camp.

I had gone to Abilene a few days previously to Woolworth's Christmas shopping. That was the first year the store opened there and for \$5.00 you could buy as much as you can now for \$110.00. I happily made my selections from their lavaliers, bracelets, dolls, and doll houses. There were even wind-up toys, such as frogs, lizards, monkeys, and cows. Then all the neighbors helped me make doll dresses, cook pies, cakes and cookies galore. I baked a ham and a turkey with all the trimmings and was ready for our trek.

We loaded up and were ready to start out. I in the first wagon with four little girls and the old stove, and my husband with the feed and other things in the second. From the chuck-wagon kit some bundle stuff was hanging out to toll the mules along that Wright tried to keep following. But somehow those twenty head of young mules did not want to take the road.

The neighbors and kin had gathered to see us off. They all rushed around to try to keep the mules together but the mules outran them. Mr. Beckham sent his son, Windy (a dashing young student in high school), to get his saddle horse, round them up again, and go out on the highway apiece. After some delay, we finally got started. 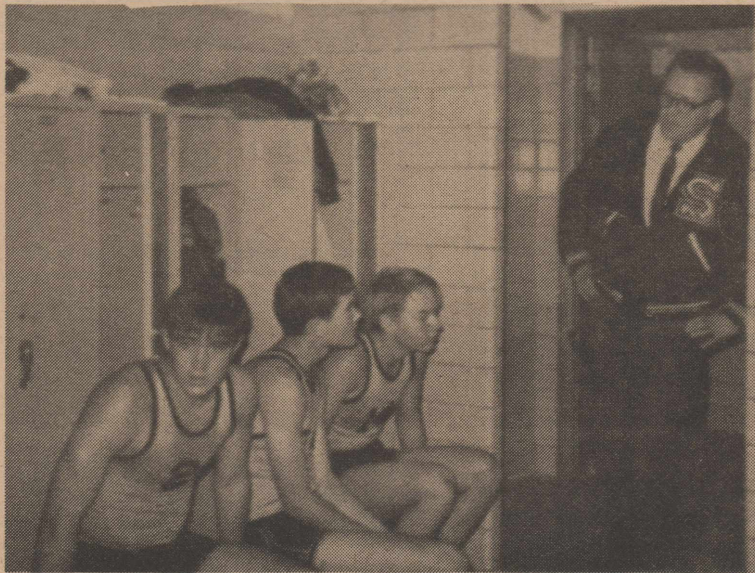
FRESHMEN

The trips back and forth from Seminole to Kermit were rough.

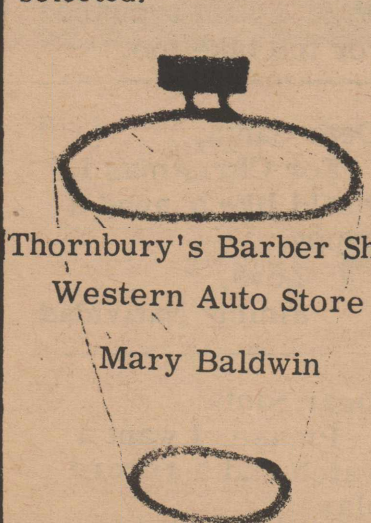

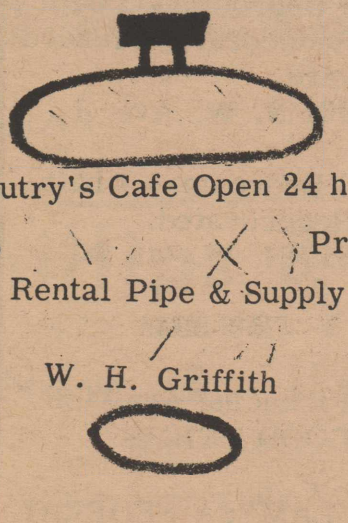

Bennett had 14 points and Nelson had 12 points.

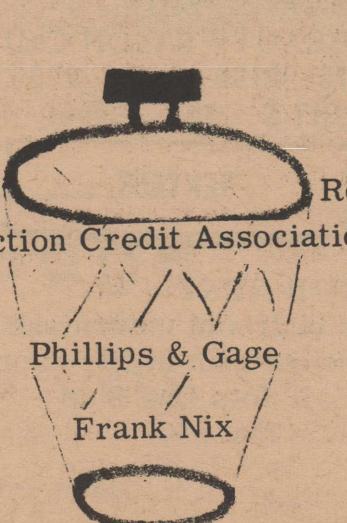
Satterwhite led the Freshman "B" team with 15 points in a losing effort against Andrews Monday night 54 - 44.

Miss Inez Brock, former resident of Seminole, died in Carlsbad, New Mexico, Monday, December 18, after a lengthy illness.

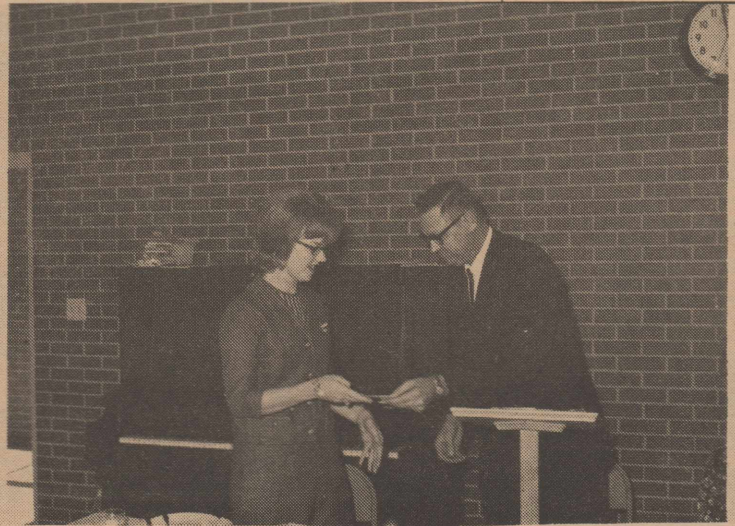

After a good many days and nights at the task the M. S. Doss Youth Center decorating committee, under the supervision of Mrs. Lloyd Coffman, has finished its work, and the center is gayly attired in its holiday finery. Poinsettias fashioned of silver, red and green foils serve as the theme of this year's decorations. They are especially prominent in a spectacular poinsettia Christmas tree, and in two huge wreaths hanging at each end of the auditorium. Both the tree and the wreaths are intertwined with numerous red Christmas lights, which reflect beautifully off the varicolored foils.

The frame of the tree, which stands fifteen feet in height, was constructed by Mr. K. W. Whisenant. Mr. Whisenant made the tree in sections at his home. He then transported these sections to the center and assembled them into the tall, symmetrical, pyramid shaped structure.

At this point Mrs. Coffman and her decorators began their work. They covered the form with approximately one-hundred of the large poinsettias, and one-hundred lights. The triangular base and the trunk of the tree were covered in the silver, red and green foils.

The most time consuming part of the job, perhaps, was the making of the poinsettias. This entailed cutting out hundreds of petals and leaves, gluing together fronts and backs on stems and veins of wire, and then assembling them into the finished flowers. A total of some eleven hundred feet of foil, thirty inches in width was utilized in the overall project.

In addition to the poinsettias, red garlands were strung the length of the auditorium from each of the two rows of pendant lights, with red satin balls suspended with red ribbon from every light. Complimentary short strands of garland were alternated with poinsettias on each of the side walls.

Looking over the television set, which is mounted above the patio exit, is a life-sized image of Santa. He is flanked by two large, flowing arrangements of fabric poinsettias, in wicker baskets, by each of which a small likeness of Santa stands. A shimmering silver and red foil greeting of Merry Christmas is strung across the base of the console. Completing the main features of the decor are a number of white and red kissing balls hung from the ceiling and lights.

The public is invited to come by at any time the center is open to view these decorations.

Even though we were traveling across the nation's best coast-to-coast highway, Highway 80, it was nothing but a graded road. There was very little travel other than wagons and buggies going to town.

The children were nearly frantic because we did not go into town and said, "Oh, Daddy, you know Santa Claus can't find us out here on this bare hill." He told them they would not let us camp in town with all our stock, and we could not go on.

Since the older ones were so disappointed and could hardly eat, we fixed the beds early, - - one under the spring seat for Norma and Mary, the other one in back for the two little girls and myself.

When the children pulled off their shoes and stockings Norma asked, "Are we going to hang up our stockings?"

Mary rather huffily replied, "Do you think I'm crazy? You know Santa Claus won't find us out here in this covered wagon. Daddy didn't even go to town.

Norma said, "Maybe mamma hid something."

Mary felt and smelled of everything in the wagon, then finally lay down, pulled the cover over her head, and said, "I couldn't even smell an apple."

Norma sat there looking at her stockings and at last climbed up in the spring seat, hung up her stockings and at last drifted off to sleep.

When all were safely asleep and nothing was stirring, I cautiously climbed out of my wagon. We got the trunk with the precious cargo out from under the feed and placed each child's Christmas present near the child, except Mary who had not hung up her stockings. We filled one stocking with candy, apples, oranges, nuts, and chewing gum. The other one had a big curly-headed doll sticking out, a set of dishes, and other presents hanging on the bow.

The father and son slept in the next wagon with their clothes on to be ready for the excitement when it came to life. When the farmers' roosters in the area began to crow at the crack of dawn, the trusting little girl looked up to see her stockings bulging out with things. With her cry of joy the fun started.

The doubtful one remorsefully said, "Oh, if I had only hung my stockings up." Her daddy was so sorry for her that he told her to look around. Maybe Santa had left her something, too. She found her package hidden under the springs, and when she saw it contained all the things her sister's did; she was truly happy. The little ones were happy, also. The boy found a lariat rope, spurs, a warm jacket and gloves, a knife, and fire crackers. Even mother and daddy found some presents and much joy this Christmas Day! It was not the place we had our Christmas, but the spirit of Christmas that made us happy.

As the day was calm and sunshiny, the older girls walked along bedecked in jewelry and carrying their dolls. They skipped and hopped, repeated "The Night Before Christmas," and sang Christmas carols. Occasionally we would hear a commotion and would look back to see if the mules were all right, but they would be munching along on the toll feed. The stir was only the girls squealing and screaming as they tried to get out of the way of the fire crackers their brother had thrown under their feet.

As we stopped to feed and water the stock and eat our lunch, the farmers and their families would come out and smile at the children. They would invariably say, "Happy Christmas to you. Did Santa find you in your covered wagon?"

The children would answer, "Oh, yes. It was even easier for Santa to get in the wagon than down the chimney."

Norma and Mary invited everyone we met to look in the wagon to see the little girls, warm and comfortable, and happily playing with their dolls and dollhouse.

Often the onlookers would say, "Well, friend,


where are you headed?"

When we told them Dawson County, they would shake their heads and say, "Better settle here. We will help you find a place. They say there is nothing out there but prairie dogs, rattlesnakes, and sandstorms."

With some misgiving we pulled on, as we had already invested our savings there. We expected to make the trip in five days, which did not seem so long to us then. We had made a covered wagon journey from Arkansas to Texas when our oldest child was ten months old, and it had taken us twenty-one days.

Many eventful years have passed since our move to Dawson County. We have made many other trips, not in covered wagons. In 1955 my husband flew to the Baptist World Alliance in London, visited Europe, and toured the Holy Land. That same year we celebrated our Golden Wedding Anniversary. We have had many Christmases since then and almost every year our six children have returned to celebrate Christmas Day with us. But none of our Christmases have been more memorable than that of 1916, for it was one of the happiest times of our lives.

Our children still cherish this Christmas story. It has been told many times to them, our grandchildren, and our great-grandchildren who always say, "Tell it again."
