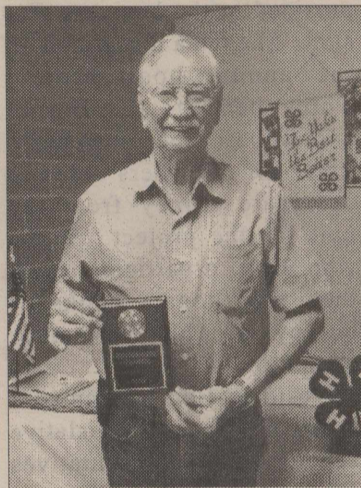

The Board of Directors of the West Coke County Hospital District met in regular session September 29, 2011. President Mary Bessent called the meeting to order at 9:35 am, and the invocation was given. The minutes from the previous meetings were approved, and absent members were excused from the August meeting. New Board member Farrell Jean Washam was sworn into office by Judge Roy Blair. The Board is very proud to have Ferrell

Jean serve in this capacity, and extends a word of welcome.

The Board went into Executive session at 9:40 am to discuss personnel. The Board returned to regular session at 10:02 am, and voted to give Roger Alexander a bonus, in appreciation for the excellent job he is doing as administrator of the facility.

In the staffing update, Roger informed the Board of the need of a janitor and CNA. Roger introduced the Board to Shanda O'Neal, the new DON. The Board expressed its pleasure at having Shanda join the staff. Roger also reported there are currently 10 residents in the Alzheimer's Unit, and 48 residents total in the Care Center as of the meeting date.

The Board then discussed capital projects. The work on the replacement of the water pipes and the ceilings in the halls has begun. The Board discussed renovation of the Alzheimer unit and Roger will begin procuring bids, as time allows.

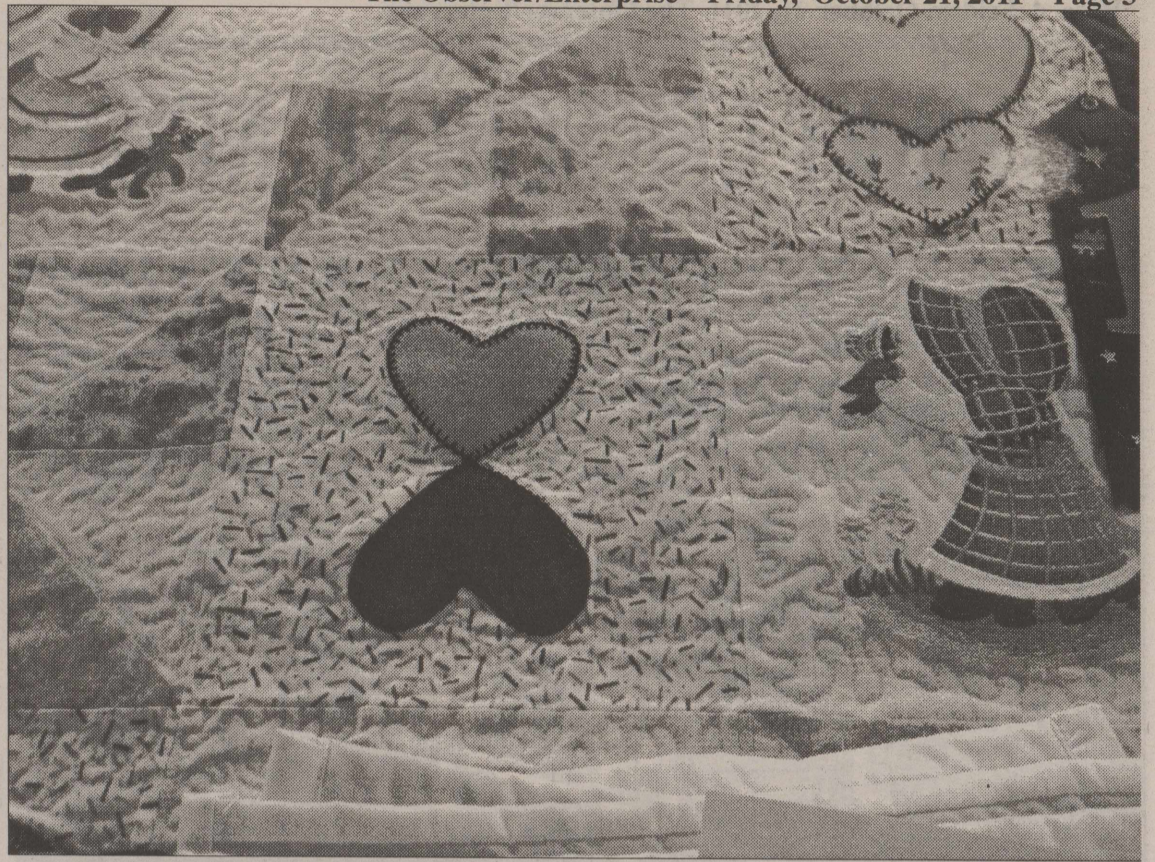

**Congressman Conaway accepting applications for service academies for class of 2016**

Congressman K. Michael Conaway invites area high school seniors interested in attending one of the United States' military service academies to apply for nominations through his San Angelo Regional Office. The Nomination Process to be considered for an appointment to a service academy, an applicant must meet the eligibility requirements established by law and be nominated from an authorized person including a Member of the United States Senate for the

House of Representatives. Congressman Conaway may nominate applicants who are legally domiciled within the boundaries of the 11th District of Texas. There are five Service Academies: The United States Air Force Academy, Naval, Military, Merchant Marine, and the Coast Guard Academies. Nominations are required for all but the U.S. Coast Guard Academy.

The application period for students who will enter college next year ends October 24, 2011. Interested applicants should contact Congressman Conaway as soon as possible.

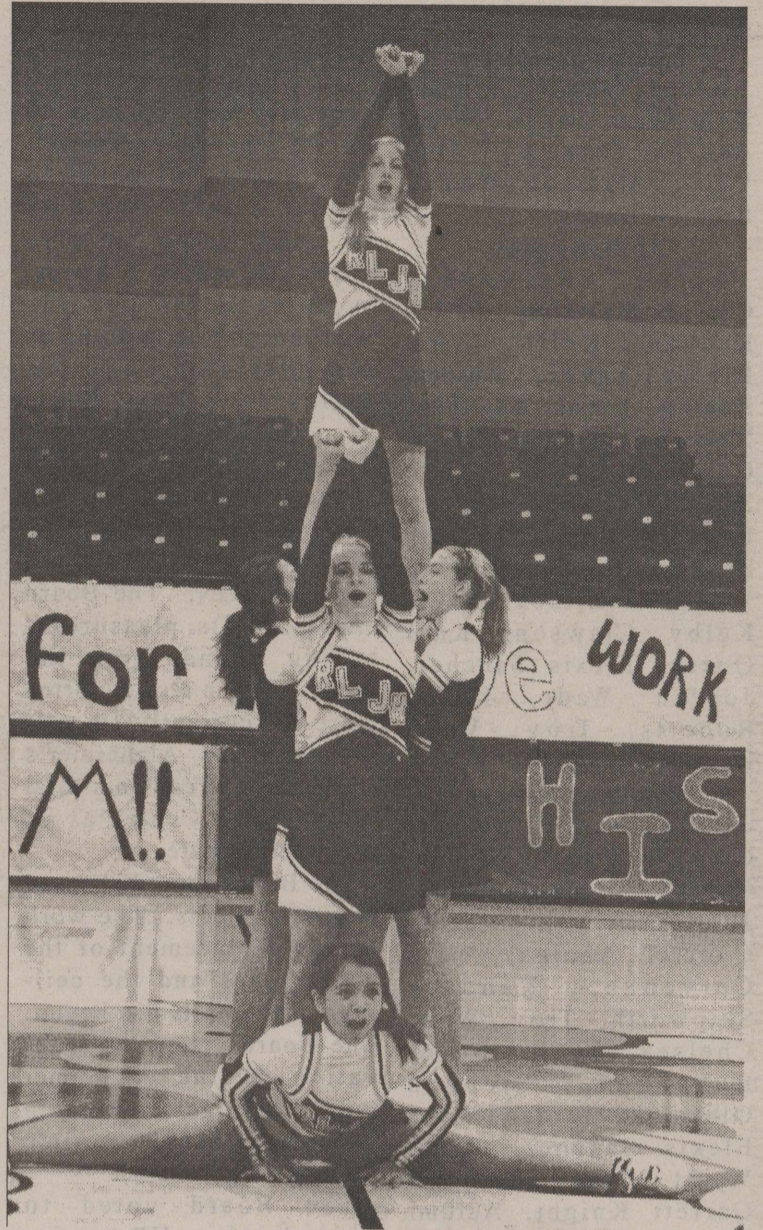

**THE UL HOME SAFETY PLANNING GUIDE**

**6 Days To A Safer Home**

When you're a parent, safety is an important part of protecting your family.

You probably know about childproofing and some of the other safety basics, but what about bigger safety issues, such as fire, floods or other natural disasters that can strike without warning?

UL is here to help. Below you'll find one easy thing to do each day for a week to help plan and prepare to keep your family safer. The end result is a safer home in seven simple steps.

**Day 1**

**Create a Fire Escape Plan**

Draw a simple floor plan of your home. On it, mark two exits from every room, including windows, and an assembly point outside of your house. Write "Call 911" on the escape plan and post it in a central location, such as the refrigerator door. Hold a fire drill with all members of your family to be sure everyone understands the plan.

**Day 2**

**Install/Check Smoke Alarms**

Smoke alarms save lives. Install at least one UL-listed smoke alarm on every level of your home, including the basement and outside each sleeping area. Once you have them installed, test smoke alarms once a week and replace smoke alarm batteries twice a year. So go on, check those batteries!

**Day 3**

**Pick a Meet-up Spot**

An important part of any safety plan is a designated

meet-up spot in case disaster prevents you from reaching your home. Choose a meeting place away from the home with your kids and make sure they know how to get there. Families that have discussed where they'll meet and what to do in different situations are always better prepared when disaster strikes.

**Day 4**

**Choose an Emergency Contact**

Designate an out-of-town relative or friend to be your family's emergency contact and keep their information with you at all times. Let that relative know that they are your family's go-to person.

**Day 5**

**Review Kids' Information**

When old enough, children should know their full name, parents' full names, address (including city and state), home phones numbers (including area code) and parents' work phone numbers or cell phones. Younger kids can work on learning their full name and phone number first and then your out-of town contact as they are able. A fun way to teach younger children your phone number? Turn it into a song.

**Day 6**

**Prepare an Emergency Kit**

- Kits should include:
- \* five days worth of non-perishable food and water
  - \* can opener
  - \* flashlight
  - \* Portable emergency radio (hard-work, solar-powered or batter operated)
  - \* Batteries
  - \* Any prescription medication needed by family members
  - \* First aid kit
  - \* List of phone numbers for relatives
  - \* Neighbors and utility company phone numbers and information
  - \* Pictures and descriptions of your family
  - \* If you have pets, include 5 days' worth of canned pet food and water, sturdy leashes, harnesses or carriers,

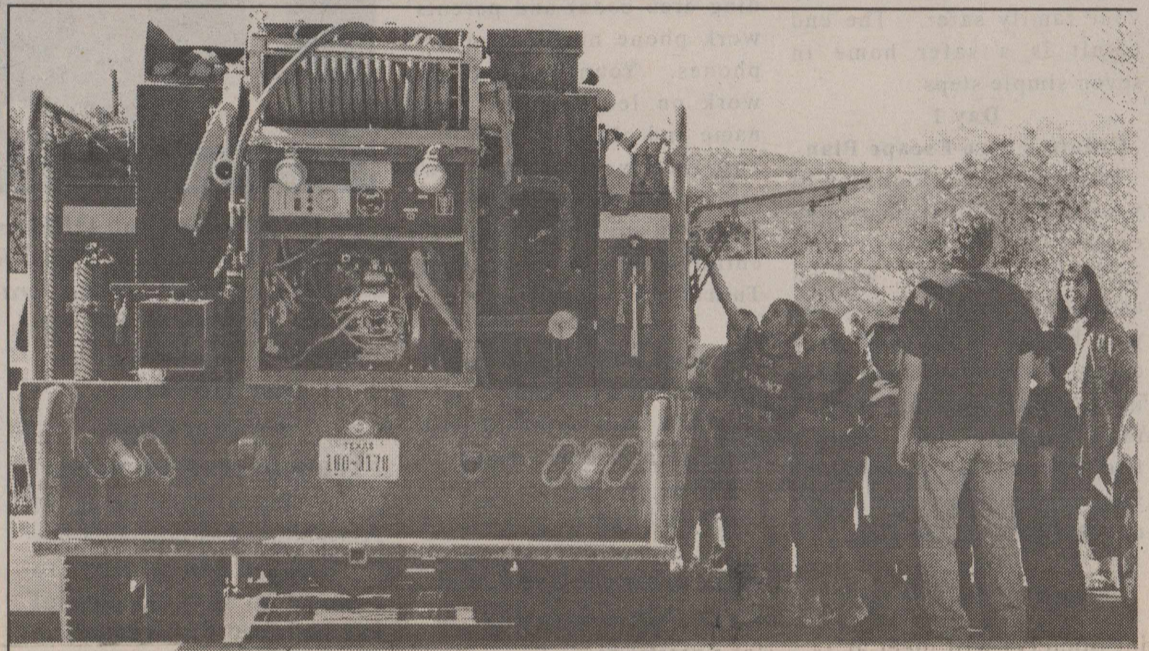
