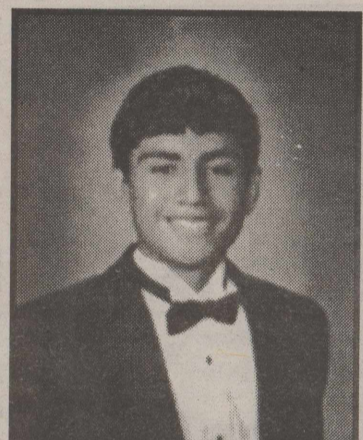
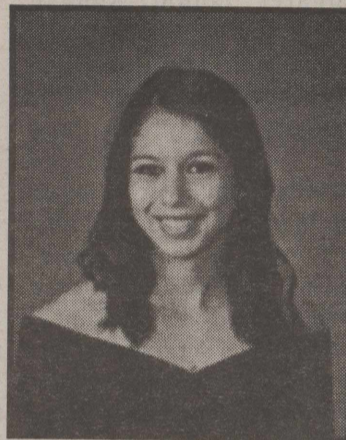
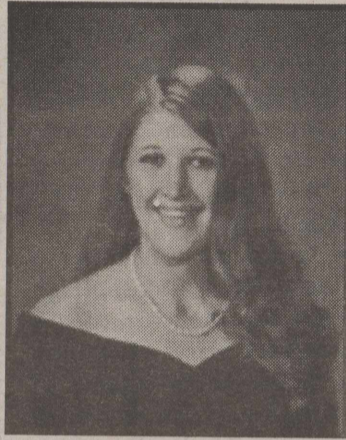

The Coke County Historical Commission will hold a meeting on Thursday, May 24, at 3 pm at the Old Jail. Preservation work is almost complete on the 1904 jail. The restoration of the lock-up system is pending the arrival of Southern Folger Detention company engineers of San Antonio whose founder patented the lock-up system in the Old Jail.

The next stage of the preservation project will be the construction of a building on the back of the lot which will contain a bathroom, workroom, and a secure area for bequests to the historical commission.

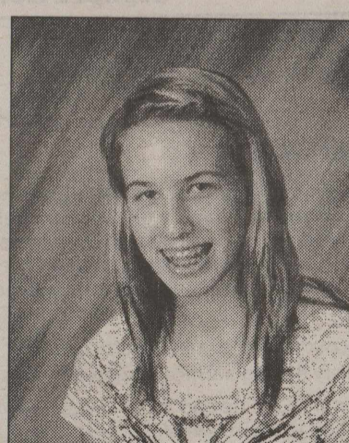
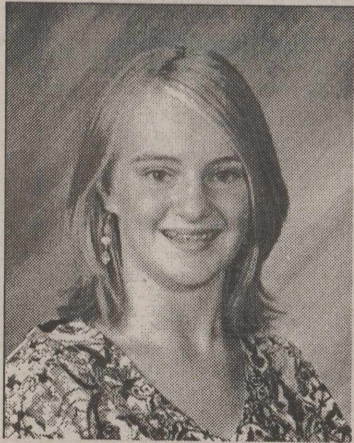
Bronte ISD office hours for the summer will be 8 am to 3 pm, Mondays through Fridays. The office will be closed the week of July 4th.

Margaret enjoyed helping with Myna Kay's school activities and later enjoyed watching her grandchildren participate in sports, cheer-leading and whatever they were involved in at the time.

Edna Louise (Lou) Wright, daughter of W.N. (Bill) Wright and Dorothea Bewick Wright, died on Saturday, May 19, 2012, in Robert Lee. She was born May 30, 1941, in Alpine, Texas.

A graduate of Reagan County (Big Lake) High School, she later worked as a medical secretary. After moving to her home outside of Robert Lee, she attended emergency medical service courses and was certified as a paramedic EMT. She was the

first female paramedic in the thirteen county Concho Valley.

She helped start the West Coke County E.M.S. and later was the founding director of the North Runnels Hospital (Winters) E.M.S. Active in the Texas Association of EMTs (TAEMT), she served as state secretary for a number of years. She was selected as the statewide EMT of the Year in 1985. She graduated from Angelo State University in May 1985 and successfully passed her state board examinations in July 1985.

She worked as a registered nurse for many years and was certified in both general nursing practice and emergency nursing. Her knowledge and dedication to excellent patient care led her to a position as a

Quality Assurance nurse. Active for many years in the Order of the Eastern Star, she was a past matron and a 50-year member.

She retired from both E.M.S. and professional nursing in 1997 after a long battle with diabetes and heart disease.

She is survived by her sister, Dorothea Helen Wright of Robert Lee, as well as a niece and nephew.
