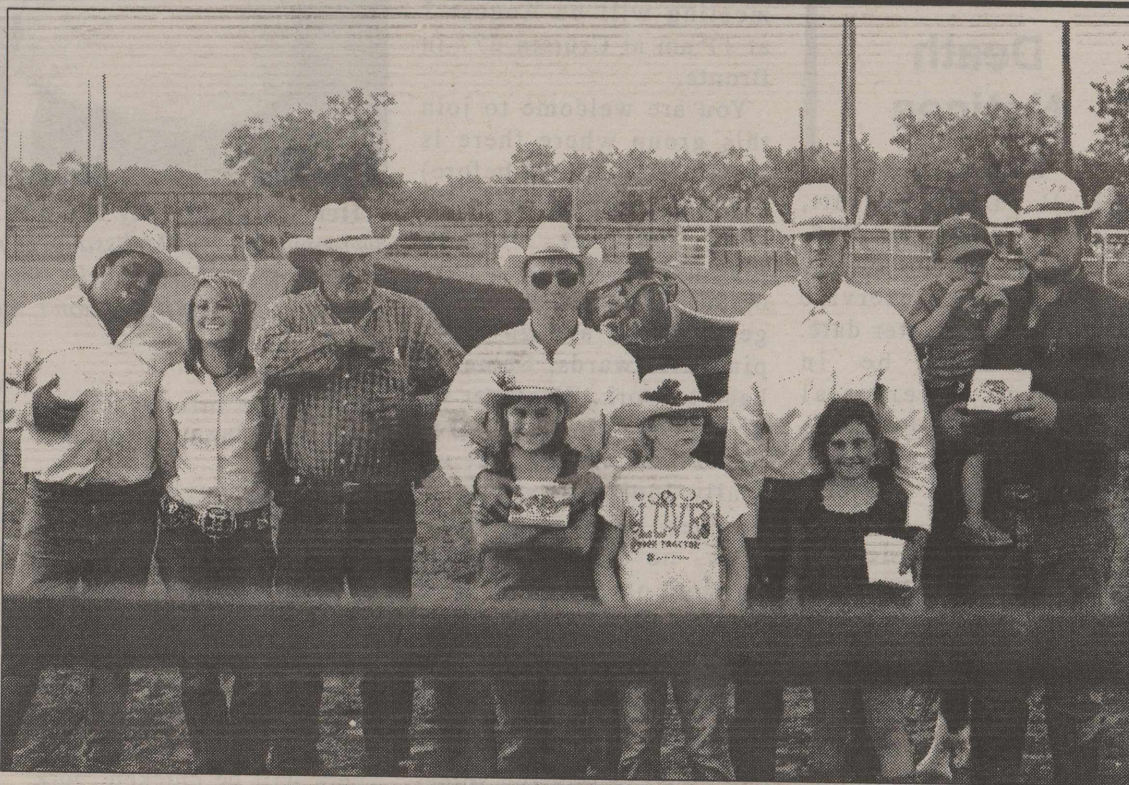

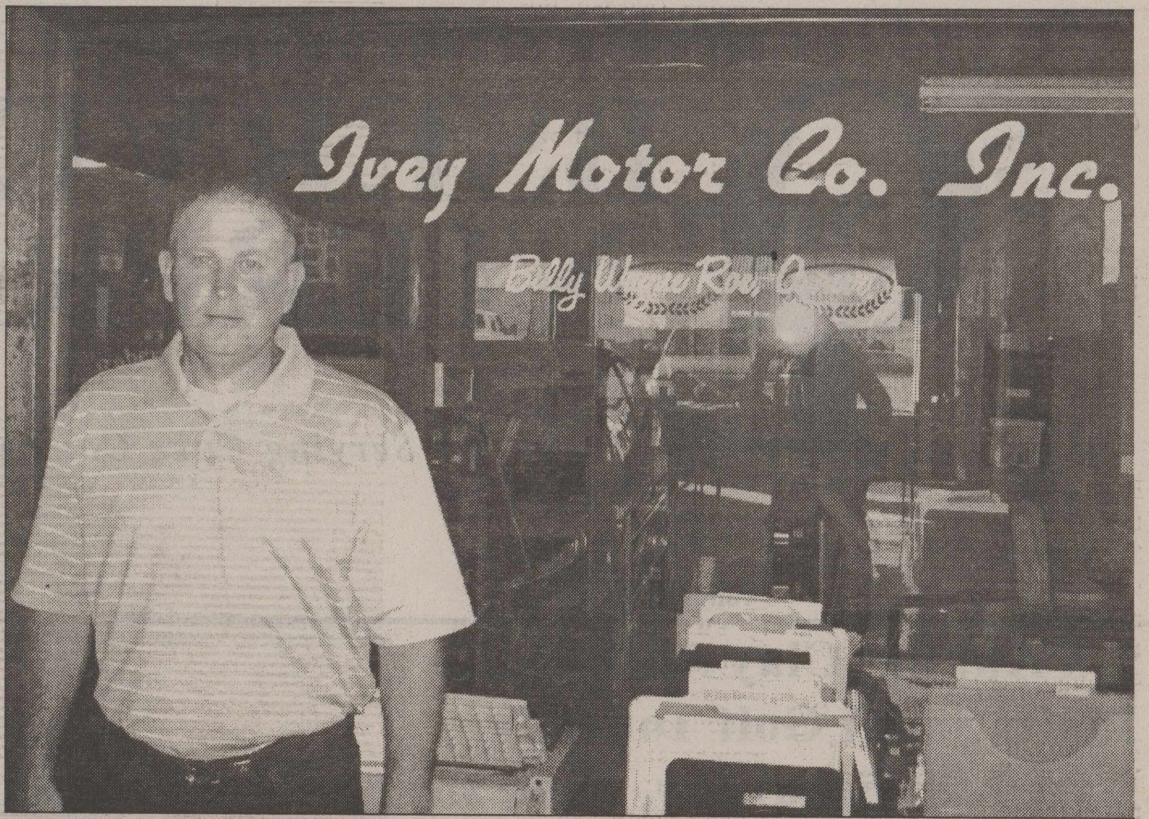
**Red Hat society posts schedule**
