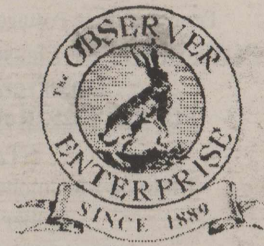

### Eleven BJH graduates honored

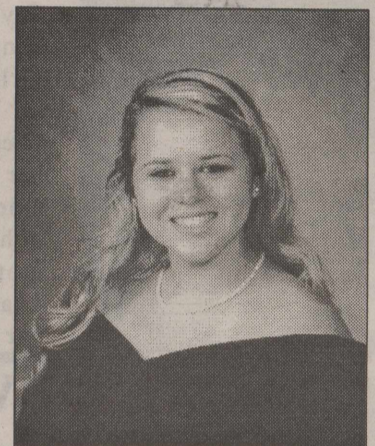
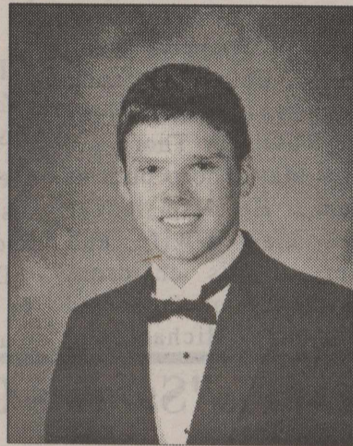
A promotion program for Blackwell Junior High School 8th Graders will be held Thursday evening, May 30, 2013, at 7 pm in the BCISD Cafetorium.

Money (\$12) may be donated to put together a health kit or items for health kits may be purchased and include the following:

- Hand towel (15"x25" to 17"x27") Kitchen, cleaning and microfiber towels are not acceptable.
- Washcloth
- Comb - The comb needs to be sturdy. Rattail combs and combs without handles are acceptable, but

pocket combs and picks are not.

- Metal nail file or clipper - No emery boards or toe nail clippers please.

- Bath Size Soap - Soap needs to be in original packaging and 3 ounces are larger

- Toothbrush - This needs to be adult size and still in the original packaging.

- 6 Adhesive Bandages 3/4" to 1" size

- 1 Plastic bag - one gallon sealable bags only

- \$1 to purchase toothpaste
