Officers of numerous area law enforcement agencies descended on west Coke County last week. On Friday evening, May 8, 2015, Coke County Chief Deputy Brandon Neal and Deputy Anthony Lopez were searching for a man believed to be in the Lake Spence area. An arrest warrant (motion to revoke probation on an aggravated assault with a deadly weapon conviction) was issued out of Tom Green

County for Dennis Cranfill, 53 of San Angelo. Coke County Deputies believed Cranfill might be responsible for several break-ins around the lake where food had been taken. When found by Neal and Lopez, Cranfill barricaded himself and his co-habitant in a house on Driftwood (off of Highway 158 west of Robert Lee). He soon released the woman. East Coke County Ambulance Service transported her to a San Angelo hospital with injuries.

Coke County Sheriff Wayne McCutchen okayed the use of tear gas and entrance to the house by the Tom Green County Sheriff's Office SWAT team when Cranfill refused to cooperate. He was taken into custody on the warrant and later charged with aggravated assault with a deadly weapon and aggravated kidnapping.

Emergency responders included members of the Coke County Sheriff's Office, East Coke County Ambulance Service, Robert Lee Volunteer Fire Department, Texas Rangers, Tom Green County Sheriff's Office and Department of Public Safety.

Saturday's Election results posted

The local government entity election and special election was held Saturday, May 9, 2015.

The entities with contested elections included the Cities of Bronte and Robert Lee. and Blackwell Consolidated School District.

Also decided in the May 9 election was the status of liquor sales for on premises consumption in Coke County's Precincts 2 and 4 (the east side of the county). The motion was passed by an overwhelming margin.

The City of Bronte needed to fill three seats currently held by Misti Bedford, Paula McWright and Jodie Arrott. Vote totals for the full terms were Misti Bedford 82, Martin Lee 49, Paula McWright 46 and Colin Pope 26. Arrott and Bedford are returning to the council and will be joined by Lee.

The City of Robert Lee had three 2 year terms to fill. The terms of council members Janie Munoz, Leroy Casey and Susan McCormick are expiring. Also, Mayor John Jacobs had announced his retirement. The remainder of his term will be filled by Leroy Casey with 82 votes. Janie Munoz and Suc McCormick both ran for reelection to the council, facing

Roger Alexander and Toni Rainwater. Vote totals were Toni Rainwater 75, Janie Munoz 67, Roger Alexander 54 and Susan McCormick 33. Munoz is returning to the council and will be joined by Rainwater and Alexander.

Two three-year Trustee positions were on the ballot for the School District election in Blackwell. Incumbents Skipper Gaston and Ray Walls were joined on the ballot by Brandy Scott. Walls and Gaston were returned to the board with 57 and 55 votes respectively. Scott had

Local farmers support trade authority bills

Coke County farmers and ranchers support legislation that expands international trade for farmers and ranchers.

The Trade Promotion Authority (TPA) bills will greatly benefit Texas farmers and ranchers, said Coke County Farm Bureau President John Ross Copeland. TPA streamlines negotiations and strengthens the U.S. position at the bargaining table. It is central to completing key trade negotiations already under way, such as the Trans-Pacific Partnership.

"U.S. agriculture will not grow unless our farmers and ranchers can compete in the international marketplace," John Ross Copeland said. "We lose potential markets if we cannot negotiate and ratify trade agreements through TPA."

The United States is the world's leader in agricultural exports, coming off a record year of \$152 billion in exports last year.


"TPA will keep that trend moving forward," John Ross Copeland said.

Just six months in, the Texas Beef Checkoff posted revenue of \$3.4 million.






