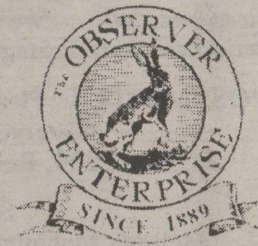

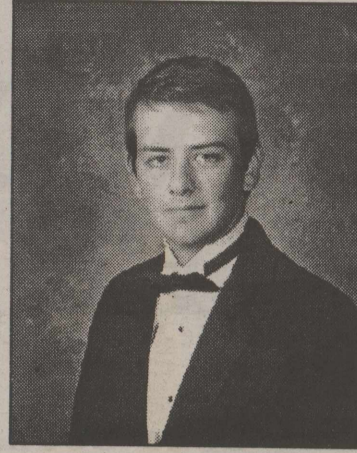
woman and would give everything she had to help someone else and make their life better. She would help anyone in need and opened her home to many over the last few years.

The Coke County Commissioners Court met in regular session May 10, 2016 at the courthouse in Robert Lee. Members of the court present included County Judge, Roy Blair, Commissioner, Pct. #1 Gene Montgomery, Commissioner Pct. #2 Paul Williams, Commissioner, Pct. #3 Gaylon Pitcock, Commissioner, and Pct. #4 Joe Sefcik, Commissioner. Deputy Clerk Mary Grim was also in attendance.

The meeting opened with prayer given by Judge Blair and pledge to the flag was recited.

Judge Blair announced the presence of a quorum.

Comm. Sefcik made a motion to approve the minutes for April 26th. The motion was seconded by Comm. Williams. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's Report was presented by Treasurer Hal Spain. Commissioner Pitcock made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Montgomery. Motion carried.

**Texas Farm Bureau solicits AgLead, FarmLead participants**

Texas Farm Bureau (TFB) is now accepting applications for its AgLead and FarmLead programs.

Strong agricultural leadership doesn't only happen in the field. It happens beyond the fencerow—in local and state organizations, court rooms and Congress, said County Farm Bureau President John Ross Copeland.

Figuring out where to develop those leadership skills can be difficult.

"Texas Farm Bureau's leadership programs—AgLead and FarmLead—help grow our future leaders," said. "They help farmers and ranchers develop

the skills to lead Texas communities and agriculture."

AgLead and FarmLead are open to TFB members ages 25-40 and above age 40 as of Sept. 1, respectively. Through the two-year programs, participants travel across Texas, the country and the world to discover agriculture from a new perspective.

"Discovering new innovative agricultural techniques and discussing agricultural policy with elected officials at the state and national levels is just part of the programs," John Ross said. "From leadership to communication and public policy to regulatory advocacy, program participants get to see just how the decisions made elsewhere can affect our lives."
