# TPWD sets another long dove season

I don't know how this year's dove season could be better than last year, but this year promises to be even better, with the continued good growing conditions that began last year and have continued this past spring and summer. Texas Parks and Wildlife officials are expecting another great year for dove hunting, and they have set this year's dove season to match last year's ninety day season.

As to numbers, I have seen an increased number of mourning doves in the area due to the good feeding conditions. I am also seeing some flocks of whitewing doves zooming in and around deer feeders recently. Also, in recent years we have experienced a large increase in collared doves, and this year is no exception. This adds up to a pretty good forecast for the additional late season running upcoming season.

As in most good dove hunting years, some of the best hunting opportunities will be at the very beginning of the season. Once

by Hal Spain pressure, they'll be off to a safe zone, where they don't get shot at so much. If conditions get right to bring some northern birds into our area, we'll have some real hunting opportunities.

Friday morning, September 1, 2017, will mark the beginning of the new dove season in Coke County and throughout the Northern and Central zones of Texas. The Northern dove hunting zone is basically the area above Interstate 20, with the Central zone being bordered on the north by Interstate 20 and on the southern end by Interstate 10. The South zone is below Interstate 10, and their season does not open until September 22.

The lengthened season in our area (Central Zone) will run from September 1 through November 5, 2017, with an from December 15, 2017 through January 7, 2018. In the North Zone the season will run through November 12, 2017, with their late season set for those birds get some hunting December 15, 2017 through

Legal shooting hours are from one-half hour before sunrise to sunset. Don't forget to plug those autoloaders and pump shotguns, as dove are considered migratory birds, and plugs must be in place so that the firearm can hold no more than three shells.

A new hunting license will be required to hunt this fall, along with a \$7.00 migratory game bird stamp if you will be hunting dove or waterfowl, plus another \$7.00 stamp if you will be hunting upland game birds, which include quail, turkey, and pheasant. If you will be hunting waterfowl, you will also need to purchase a \$25 migratory game bird stamp endorsement (duck

By Kay Ledbetter After such a positive response last year, four new Rancher Leasing Workshops covering grazing, hunting and livestock leases are scheduled across the state by the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service.

The free programs are funded by the Southern Extension Risk Management Education Center, said Tiffany Dowell Lashmet, AgriLife Extension agricultural law specialist in Amarillo.

"Last year, 100 percent of participants said they would recommend these programs to a friend, so we decided to offer them in more locations," Lashmet said.

The schedule will be:

- Sept. 1, 8:30 a.m.-1 p.m., Hildebrand Equine Complex, 3240 F&B Road, College Station. Sept. 19, 8:30 a.m.-1 p.m., AgriLife Extension office for Frio County, 400 S. Pecan St., Pearsall.

- Oct. 19, 8:30 a.m.-1 p.m., Tom Green 4-H Center, 3168 N. U.S. Highway 67, San Angelo.

Lashmet said lunch will be provided by two sponsors: Ag Workers Insurance for the Lubbock, College Station and San Angelo programs, and Security State Bank for the Pearsall program.
