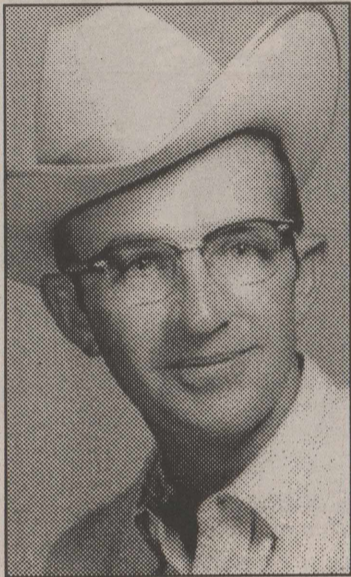

This event benefits the Bronte Volunteer Fire Department.

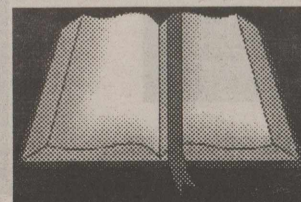

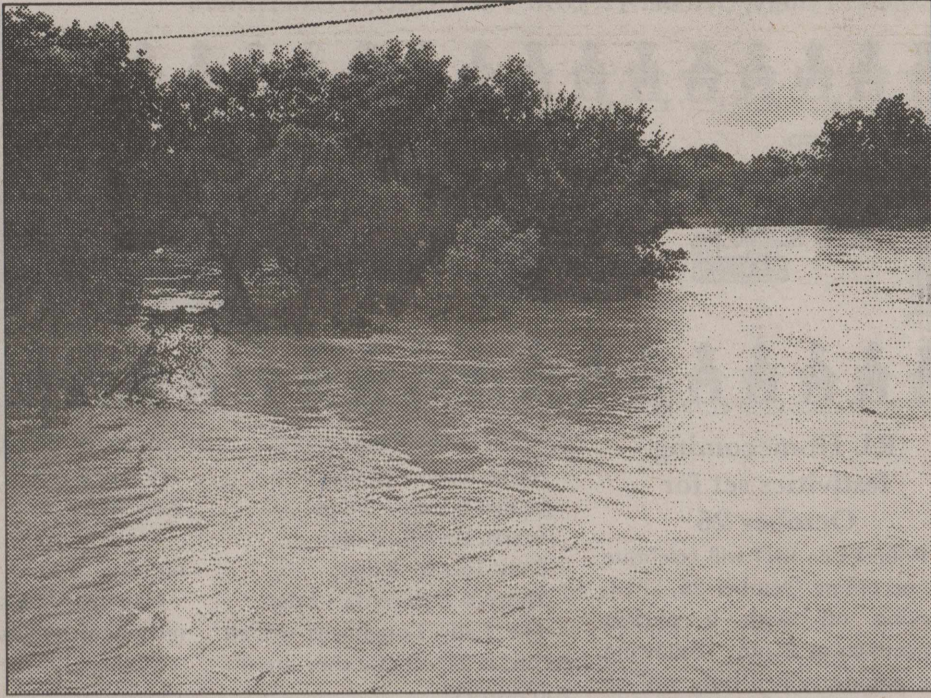
