



Perry announces initiative to expand online coursework

Gov. Rick Perry today announced an expansion of the Texas Virtual School Network (VSN), which will improve access to high quality courses for high school students, including those in rural schools and those whose parents choose to educate them at home. Students who have dropped out of traditional high schools will be able to enroll in a virtual high school program using the VSN.

"The growing capacity of the Internet and the increasing sophistication of distance-learning technologies are making it increasingly possible for students to take non-traditional approaches to continuing and completing their education, Gov. Perry said. "It's time to expand our use of these technologies to our state's more vulnerable students as a way to decrease our state's dropout rates even farther."

Students participating in the VSN will be able to take up to four courses online each semester that meet graduation requirements, or supplement their current coursework with additional online classes. Additionally, this proposal would allow home-schooled students to participate in the virtual courses at no ad-

Participation in these courses is aimed at bolstering a student's education, providing access to accelerated instruction and additional coursework that may not be offered at their campus.

"The Texas Virtual School Network is a powerful tool that can used to give dropouts, or potential dropouts, another option for high school success," Texas Education Commissioner Robert Scott said.

RussellGravesOutdoors **New Years Resolution - Get Outside this**

Year - Part 1

By Russell A. Graves

I'm not much of a resolution maker - never have been. However, after taking a month off from writing the column, I decided it was time to resolve

Now, I've been to the places mentioned and will probably go again but before this year ends, we should all try to get outside and do one of the following:

Curiously juxtaposed amid an expanse of creosote bushes, the Monahans sand dunes are something you have to see to believe. A virtual island in a Permian Basin sea, the narrow strip of sand dunes runs for 200 miles from just south of Monahans north into New Mexico and creates a unique habitat that's home to a variety of wildlife and supports one of the world's largest oak forests albeit the oaks themselves are of the diminutive shinoak variety. Once inside the state park, rent sand saucer and head to the back of the park where you'll find huge 30-foot-tall sand dunes reminiscent of the Sahara Desert. My kids had a blast surfing the big dunes and climbing the sand hills. 2) Hike the South Prong Canyon

On an expedition to discover a trade route from San Antonio to Santa Fe, Spanish explorer José Mares first discovered this canyon and named it Sangre de Cristo (Blood of Christ). Over 200 years later, it's still easy to see how he came up with the name. In the South Prong Canyon of the Little Red River in Caprock Canyons State Park, you'll be treated to the sight of deep red canyon walls stippled with veins of white gypsum rock. This long, narrow canyon sports a hiking trail that leads to a primitive campsite that's a mile from the parking area. For the adventurous, walk past the primitive campsite and continue on the 8-mile canyon loop trail. Along the way you're bound to see native wildlife like mule deer and armadillos and geologic wonders like giant sandstone spires that jut from the canyon floor.

3) See a Palo Duro Sunrise When the sunlight spills over the eastern rim of Palo Duro Canyon, the chasm comes alive. Deep red and yellow canyon walls almost glow in technicolor brilliance as the sun warms the 250-million-year-old canyon. This wide-open country is an inspiration to artists and is equally inspiring to casual visitors. For a leisurely morning stroll, walk the short distance to Capitol Peak and photograph the big canyon wall lit with the brilliance of a new sun. For the more adventurous, start out at least an hour before sunrise and hike all the way to Palo Duro's most famous spire - The


