Jones files "answer" to Morales petition

Commissioner Jon Jones filed his "answer", December 15, in District Court, to the recent petition by Amado Z. Morales to contest the election results.

Morales ran as a write-in candidate for Commissioner Pct. #4 against incumbent Commissioner Jon Jones on November 7, 2006. The initial election results showed Jones with 273 to Morales' 270.

A recount, November 27, 2006, asked for by Morales, gave Jones 275 votes to Morales' 271.

Morales' petition called for the court to decide on mail-in ballots that were not opened or counted because election judges deemed the ballots improperly submitted. He also argued that "there were 5-7 mail-in ballots which should have been counted as votes for the Contestant (Morales), but were not counted", and there were approximately 3 registered voters who would have voted for him, but "were denied the opportunity to cast a vote and were not given a provisional ballot."

Morales' also stated in the petition "there were 2 mailed-in ballots which cast votes for Contestant, but which never arrived and were never counted."

Jones' attorney, Bob Craig, of Craig, Terrill, Hale & Grantham, asked in the petition for the court to render an order requiring Morales to file an "amended plead-

ing" to "cure the deficiencies and ...strike the defective allegations."

Jones' answer states this is deficient because, "of its failure to provide fair notice of the identity of those persons," and there was no "fair notice provided of the grounds for counting these ballots."

Jones' answer stated the claim was deficient because "no provision of the law provides a basis

for counting ballots that never arrived.

Jones' attorney asked the Court to subtract from Morales' vote total those votes that were cast illegally for Morales if the Court rules that Morales is right in that some people who wanted to vote for him (Morales) weren't allowed to.

The answer also asks for the names, addresses, and phone numbers of any experts or witnesses who are connected to this case. Jones also requested documents, reports, or data compilation prepared by or for any testifying expert.

Judge Bryan Poff Jr., (retired), of Amarillo, has been appointed to preside over this case.

By law, District Judge Bill Smith had to recuse himself from the case because a district judge can't preside over an election contest in the district in which he is serving as judge.

PISD & LISD withdraw from Coop

In a CSSA Board meeting, December 18, the three Superintendents representing the school district's of Floydada, Lockney, and Petersburg, voted 2-1 to dissolve the CSSA Cooperative.

The dissolution came about after superintendents not only could not agree on who to hire as Director of CSSA, but also about how the hiring procedures for the Cooperative are handled.

Superintendents Jerry Vaughn (FISD), Phil Cotham (LISD),

and Joey Nichols (Petersburg) have been interviewing applicants for the position of Director for the Cooperative and narrowed the selection down to 3. Both Cotham and Nichols made it clear they wanted to hire Karen Quebe, currently a diagnostician, and a 17 year veteran, with the Cooperative. Vaughn would not agree.

The 2-1 CSSA Board vote was presented to the Floydada ISD Board on December 7. FISD trustees voted 5-1 to not accept a recommendation of the CSSA Board unless it was unanimous. (According to CSSA bylaws the FISD Board of Trustees is the governing board and ultimately must approve recommendations made by the CSSA Board)

Since the Superintendents could not reach an agreement both Cotham and Nichols voted Monday, at the CSSA meeting, to dissolve the Cooperative. Vaughn voted against the dissolution.

According to Cotham, lawyers will have to work out the details of the dissolution. "It is just like a divorce," said Cotham. "There is currently a fund balance of \$180,000 for the Cooperative. That will have to be divided up between the school districts. Assets will also have to be divided up. The property, including buses, buildings, desks, chairs, filing cabinets, etc., will have to be appraised and then divided up."

There are currently 5 full time employees working for the Cooperative who will have to find employment in other capacities or elsewhere. There are also 12-13 others who are partially funded by the state--such as bus drivers, custodians, and speech therapists.

Cotham told The Hesperian-Beacon after the meeting that he will work to try and find employment in other Cooperatives for

those left unemployed.

Lockney ISD Trustees had voted unanimously Thursday, December 14, to give Cotham the authority to withdraw or dissolve LISD's agreement with CSSA Cooperative.

The vote came after Nichols talked to the Board during Open Forum at the regular board meeting. Nichols told the board that Petersburg ISD Board had met and voted unanimously to withdraw from the Cooperative. Nichols stated his District would be seeking to be part of the EPEC (East Plains Education) Cooperative which consists of Ralls, Lorenzo, Post, Idalou, and Crosbyton.

Nichols told the LISD Board, "I'm not here to try and influence any decisions you are going to make. My stance has been made clear to the FISD Board."

"We've had more than one issue. Basically I feel this is not a workable situation for Petersburg ISD, so we're going to remove ourselves from the situation."

"I was very frustrated when Floydada ISD rejected our recommendation. I've tried to be equitable in this process and put all districts needs first."

"I think the CSSA Board should make the decisions not the fiscal board. There is not another Cooperative that works that way."

"I hate that there have been innuendos and statements regarding Karen Quebe that are not well founded. People should not be subjected to that."

LISD Trustee Lonnie Hooten asked Nichols if there would be an instance where he would change his mind.

Nichols answered, "I've learned to never say never, but I feel there will be more issues. Even if we make a decision as a board of managers we are rebuffed by the board. This is the second time. In other boards the majority rules."

"I feel now that the FISD

Board will only hear one side."

Later in the board meeting during discussion on the agenda item, Cotham told the LISD Board that he appreciated Petersburg ISD. "They've stayed (in the Coop) longer than they could have because they've been trying to be nice to us."

"A Cooperative of 2 (Floydada and Lockney superintendents) will not be workable. How do you break a 1-1 vote? And there will be some. I don't feel comfortable with a board of 2."

"If two to one can't be a majority and get things done," said Hooten, "then one to one sure won't be able to. We don't have a voice here."

"I don't want anyone to think this has anything to do with Floydada/Lockney rivalries," said Cotham. "It does not."

Before making the motion concerning the Cooperative, Trustee Robbie Long stated, "I feel bad for the people working in the Cooperative whose job will be up in the air. When we dissolve, then the blood, sweat, and tears of those who worked hard to build it is over. I feel bad that this may further divide our communities."

"But with that said, I make a motion to give Phil the authority to withdraw or dissolve LISD's agreement with CSSA Cooperative."

The vote was unanimous. Voting in favor was: Aaron Wilson, Boyd Jackson, Lonnie Hooten, Cheryl Edwards, John Quebe, and Robbie Long.

Trustee Jessie Garza was not present.

After the vote Jackson asked how much it would cost the district, if Lockney joined EPEC.

Cotham replied there would be no cost. "They don't keep a fund balance. If money is needed at the end of the year they square up with everybody. We might save some money with EPEC."

**Palo Duro Basin
Oil and Gas Update** By Tom Musser

Floydada: (This information from Mrs. Dora Ross Executive Director Floydada Economic Development Corporation): Bergstein Oilfield Services, Inc. (BOF) of Lubbock has leased the Russell Equipment red building and yard located in the 600 Block of east Houston Street Floydada for a Oil Field Service Yard. BOF Services, Inc. plans to operate three trucks out of this Floydada yard.

BOF Services, Inc. is currently providing the majority of tank and trucking Services to the ongoing Palo Duro Basin Operations.

Floyd County Pipeline Connection: (This information from Floyd County Hesperian Reporter Darwin Robinson): On Monday December 11, 2006 the Floyd County Commissioner's Court gave permission to PetroGlobe Energy U.S.A. Ltd. to use four miles of County Road 271

Right-of-Way south of Highway 62/70 for a pipeline connection from the McIntosh Lease Well #1077 into the Atmos Energy four inch pipeline which runs west-east along the south side of Floyd County Road 290. Floyd County Road 271 is located two miles west of Dougherty and runs north-south from Highway 62-70 for four miles and intersects into Floyd County Road 290. Floyd County Road 290 is located four miles south of Highway 62/70 and runs east-west for seventeen miles from the intersection of Floyd County Road 293, south of Dougherty to two miles west of Highway 62/207 where it intersects with Floyd County Road 121. The Atmos Energy four inch pipeline section that PetroGlobe is planning on connecting into comes off of the Atmos Energy six inch pipeline from Hale County which runs west-east approximately two miles south of FM Road 784. The four inch Atmos Energy pipeline begins at the connection point with the six inch pipeline one mile south of Floydada on the west side of Highway 62/207. The Atmos Energy four inch pipeline runs south for three

miles along the west side of Highway 62/207 to the intersection with Floyd County Road 290. The Atmos Energy four inch pipeline then runs east for fourteen miles along the south side of Floyd County Road 290, where it reduces down to a three inch pipeline before turning north and running into Dougherty. PetroGlobe Energy U.S.A. Ltd. will be connecting into the Atmos Energy four inch pipeline at approximately the thirteen mile mark. It was stated that PetroGlobe Energy U.S.A. Ltd. desires to start this pipeline connection project immediately and be completed and start producing gas from the McIntosh Lease Well #1077 into the Atmos Energy pipeline as soon as possible.

Floyd County: PetroGlobe Energy U.S.A., Inc. Cox Lease Well #1013 has reached total depth and is being evaluated.

Floyd, Hale and Swisher Counties: PetroGlobe Energy U.S.A., Ltd. for a second time, requests that prior to visiting their Palo Duro Basin well locations that folks obtain permission to come onto the well locations. There continues to be some problems with some unauthorized persons on PetroGlobe Energy well locations. Please note that all of PetroGlobe Energy's well locations are posted with "No Trespassing" signs.

Motley County: On Monday December 18, 2006 eField Exploration, LLC of Yorba Linda California issued a news release stating they had completed a High Resolution Electromagnetic Airborne Survey over the Columbus Resources, LP Lease interests in Motley County of the Palo Duro Basin. Columbus Resources, LP is headquartered in Flower Mound, Texas.

Dear Editor,

I am sure you have heard the expression "There are two sides to every story." After reading the article concerning the Floydada School board meeting, I feel that I need to tell my side. During the board meeting, Jerry Vaughn mentioned that the reason he could not recommend me for the position of Director of Special Education was that "...several instances of things have occurred" that involved students while he has been here. I met with Jerry Vaughn to discuss the instances. During our discussion, he mentioned three instances, but in my opinion, none dealt with students. Jerry Vaughn pointed out to me that I had violated the chain of command by giving my letter requesting that discussion concerning me be done in open session to Mr. Phil Cotham instead of my direct supervisor, Interim Director Charles Tyer. I gave my letter to Mr. Cotham because I knew he planned to attend the meeting. It is my understanding that Charles Tyer was not in attendance.

The second instance was that a Superintendent (who was a high school principal at the time

worked with me on a special education issue instead of the director. I explained to Jerry Vaughn that the principal had called me at home asking a question and I had provided him with an answer. According to my job description, the primary purpose of my position is to "provide diagnostic information and work cooperatively with personnel to provide the most appropriate programs for students with disabilities." One of the major responsibilities/duties of my job is to "consult with parents, teachers, administrators, and other relevant individuals to enhance their work with students." I did not go behind the director's back. I simply answered a question asked of me.

The third instance was the fact that on Monday prior to the board meeting, I did not sign an Admission, Review, Dismissal (ARD) form placing a student in special education. My primary role at that meeting was to discuss transition issues with the student.

Transition issues "means a coordinated set of activities for a student, designed within an outcome-oriented process that promotes movement from school to

post-school activities, including post-secondary education, vocational training, integrated employment (including supported employment), continuing and adult education, adult services, independent living, or community participation." In short, what are their goals following graduation. I completed all of the required paperwork dealing with transition. The student was not denied any services nor did I violate any special education law by not signing the ARD form. My signature as Transition Coordinator is not a required signature. These were the instances Jerry Vaughn brought to my attention.

Still unsure as to the "instances" of things involving me and students, I called the previous directors who have worked at Caprock Shared Services Arrangement (CSPA) during the time that Jerry Vaughn has been superintendent. I asked if either of them had been notified of any "instances involving students" concerning me. They were my direct supervisors and if the chain of command was followed in those cases, they would have been notified first of any problems. If, after being dealt with by the director, the problems still weren't resolved, then the superintendent would be notified. Neither of them was aware of any problems concerning me.

I have looked back at my previous evaluations done by my directors and principals to check for any comments concerning problems with me or my job performance at CSSA. During Charles Tyer's term as interim principal at A.B. Duncan, he rated me as meets expectations/exceeds expectations in the area of staff relationships for consulting with teachers, parents, students, ethics and confidentiality.

As recent as this semester during his term as interim director, Charles Tyer met with me to discuss four adjectives he had come up with to describe me. Those adjectives were "involved, caring, enthusiastic and knowledgeable." On last year's evaluation done by Wayne Morren, he rated me exceeds expectations on 6

items and clearly outstanding on 20 items addressed. He commented that I am "helpful in working with students who are insecure and uneasy about their future."

Comments from principals in the other three districts include: "always prepared and professional in all tasks," "her actions and words always uphold the best in her relationships with students, parents, teachers, and administrators," "exhibits professionalism at all times," and "is effective in all aspects of her position." For the last 17 years, I have been recommended for rehire without mention of any "instances involving students."

A comment in the paper from one board member was that "I don't think it is in the best interests of any of the students in any of the school districts for us to have a director that already appears to have some type of friction." Please explain to me what that friction is.

I would like to take this opportunity to express my appreciation to Mr. Joey Nichols and Mr. Phil Cotham for their vote of confidence in me as far as my job performance. I applaud them for making decisions with their heads, taking into consideration what is best for the special needs students in their districts. To the students and parents in all three districts that I have had the privilege to work with, you have touched my heart in many ways. I hope I have made a difference in your lives also. To the staff in all three districts that encouraged me to pursue a dream and apply for the directors job, thank you for your support and loyalty throughout this whole ordeal.

If the Floydada School Board is ever faced with a similar situation such as the one from the December 7 meeting, I implore them to investigate, for themselves, both sides of the story before they form an opinion or make a decision affecting someone's professional career. Thank you for your time.

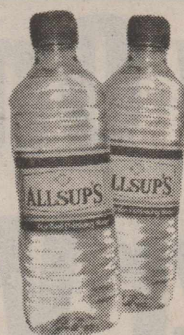

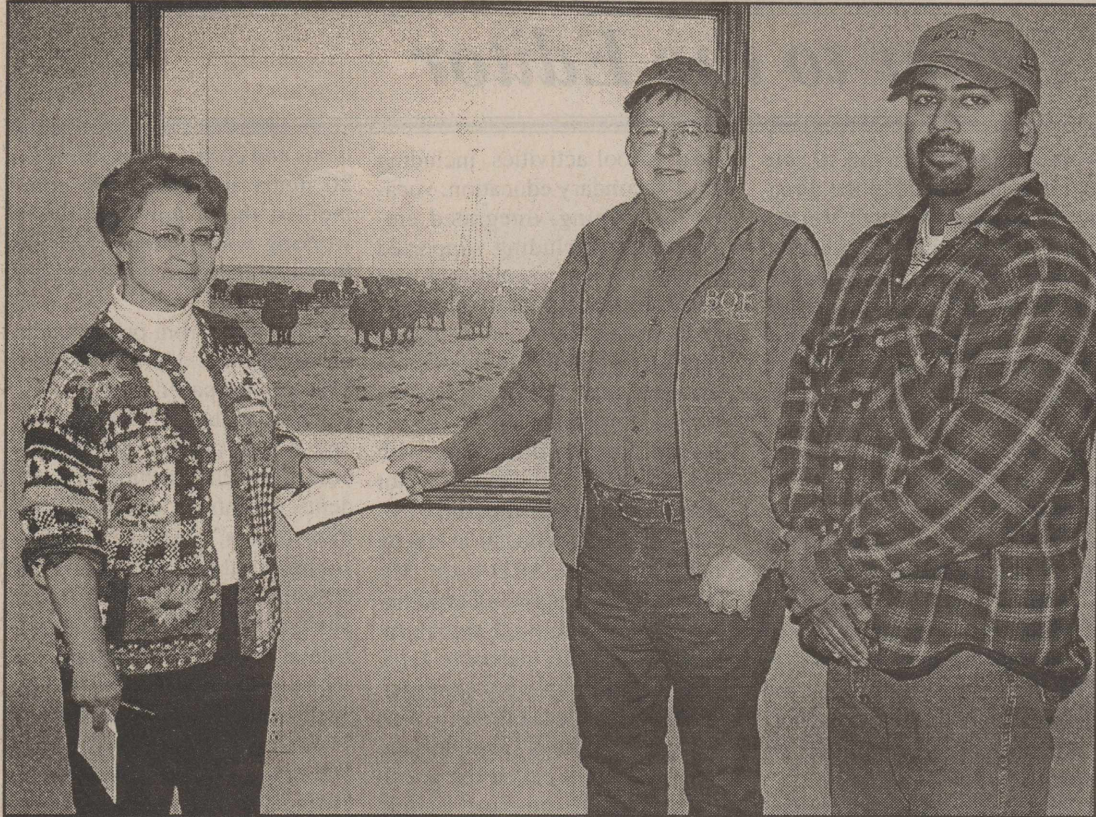

In other business the Council considered signatures to be on City of Lockney banking accounts. Discussion ensued and a motion was made and unanimously passed to have all Council member's signatures on the accounts. City Attorney Lanny Voss pointed out the fact two signatures are needed on each check which provides a security safeguard.

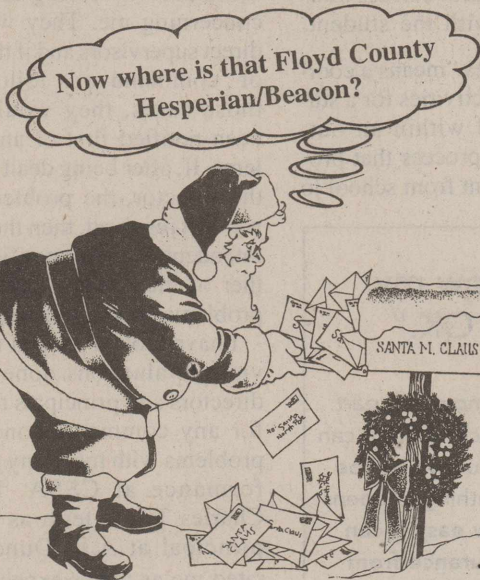

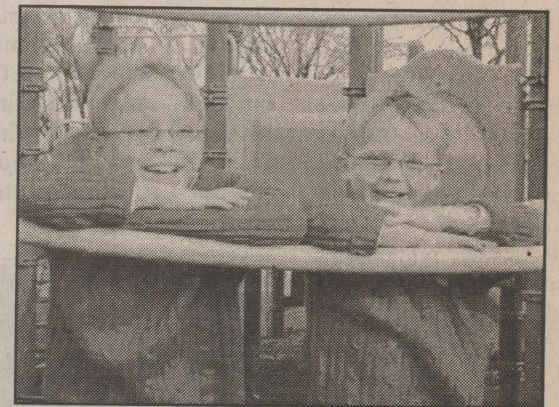

At the December 14 LISD Board meeting trustees voted to Superintendent Phil Cotham the authority to withdraw or dissolve LISD's agreement with the CSSA Cooperative (see related story).

Principals reported on campus activities to the trustees.

"We did better than the numbers show. We just didn't have as many kids to compete in all the categories that other schools had."

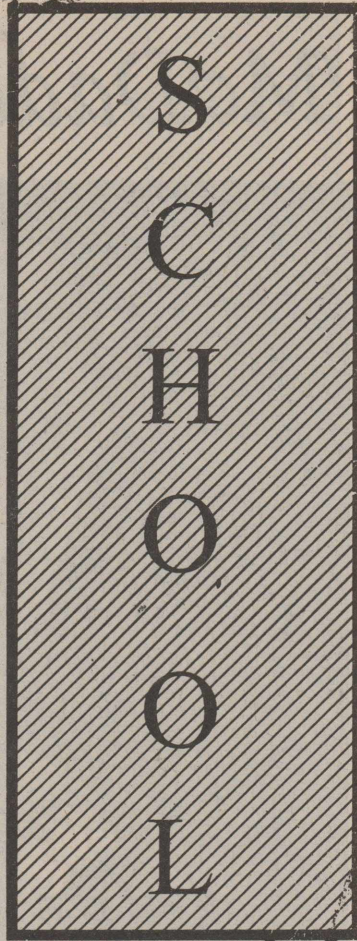
"I'm very proud of our students."

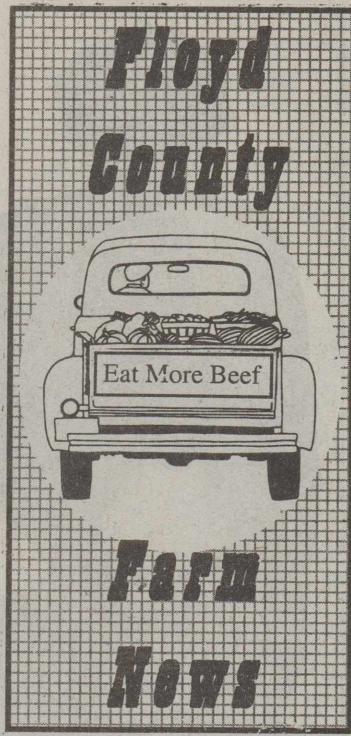

Cotton Market Weekly A service provided by Plains Cotton Cooperative Association

Cotton futures on the New York Board of Trade climbed to a fresh two-and-a-half-week high Thursday on a combination of speculative and fund buying amid bullish options trades, traders said. USDA's weekly export report also was mildly supportive to the market.

According to USDA, net export sales of U.S. cotton totaled 185,300 bales in the week ended Dec. 7. The figure was 36 percent higher than the previous week, but 29 percent less than the four-week average. Major buyers included Mexico, China, Indonesia, and Turkey.

Export commitments for the 2006-07 marketing year continue to lag behind last year's pace, however. Commitments now total 5.53 million bales, down from 9.26 million in the comparable year-ago period.

Export shipments of 191,500 bales were 35 percent more than one week earlier and 30 percent more than the four-week average. Primary destinations were China, Turkey, Mexico and Indonesia.

Meanwhile, online trading by producers in Texas, Oklahoma, and Kansas in the week ended Dec. 14 totaled 24,528 bales compared to the previous week when 24,528 bales were sold. Average prices received by producers in the most recent week ranged from 46.16 to 50.57 cents per pound compared to 45.67 to 47.80 cents per pound the previous week.

On Monday, the market essentially ignored USDA's supply/demand report that slightly increased U.S. and world ending stocks to 6.3 million bales and 51.5 million bales, respectively.

U.S. 2006-07 crop production was left unchanged at 21.3 million bales while domestic use was cut by 100,000 bales to 5.1 million. As a result, U.S. ending stocks rose five percent.

Global ending stocks were raised one percent to 51.5 million bales based on production increases in China, Brazil and Turkmenistan, as well as an increase in beginning stocks. World production rose to 115.86 million bales from 115.72 million last month.

The department also slightly lowered its 2006-07 U.S. export estimate to 16.0 million bales from 16.2 in November based on slow business from its largest customer, China. Many traders had long expected USDA to lower U.S. exports in the face of weak export data so this adjustment was largely ignored. In fact, many analysts believe exports eventually will be lowered to a figure between 14 and 15 million bales.

In other news, mild, unseasonably warm conditions ruled from the Southeast to West Texas this week. Widely scattered showers

were received in parts of the South Wednesday night, but accumulations were little more than a trace.

According to USDA's Drought Monitor data for the week ended Dec. 12, soil moisture levels ranged from normal to abnormally dry in Texas. Above-average temperatures for this time of year persist, increasing soil moisture evaporation rates. Therefore, an extended period of rainy weather is needed to ensure adequate topsoil moisture for next season.

Drought conditions prevail in central parts of Texas with key cotton growing areas categorized moderate to severe drought. Meanwhile, soils on the High and Rolling Plains were categorized abnormally dry to normal. Nevertheless, a cold, wet winter in Texas would be welcome to help kill overwintering insects and to ensure water tables are recharged.

Since its formation was first announced in early September, the Southwest Council of Agribusiness has grown steadily to include an impressive 44 members, all of whom share the common goal of extending the provisions of the 2002 Farm Bill when Congress begins development of the next iteration of U.S. farm policy in 2007.

In addition to establishing the groundwork necessary to accomplish the organization's goals and encouraging new membership over the past three months, SWCA members, led by Lubbock-based Plains Cotton Growers, Inc., have been working to finalize the establishment of the organization.

During a December 14 organizational meeting representatives from SWCA members, which include commodity organizations, financial institutions and agribusiness, gathered in the Delegate Body Room of Plains Cotton Cooperative Association in Lubbock to adopt Bylaws and elect a Board of Directors to provide oversight and direction to the organization.

Under the Bylaws adopted by the membership, members of the respective classes of Non-Profit Agriculture Representative Organizations, Agribusiness and Financial Institutions caucused to select a Board of Directors for the organization.

Following adjournment of the SWCA membership meeting, the newly elected Board of Directors convened to elect Officers that will serve the organization in 2007.

SWCA Board members elected to serve as officers of the organization are: Mark Williams, president; Dee Vaughan, Vice President; and Steve Verett, Secretary/Treasurer.

The Southwest Council is an alliance of agricultural organizations, financial institutions, and businesses, established to actively advocate for strong agricultural policy which is so important to the businesses and economy of Texas and the greater Southwest area.

The SWCA's initial focus is to seek extension of the provisions of the Farm Bill of 2002. To accomplish this goal the organization has established a working relationship with Combest, Sell & Associates (CS&A), a nationally recognized government affairs firm focused on representing the interests of rural America and agriculture in Washington, DC. CS&A's founders are former house Agriculture Committee Chairman Larry Combest and his partner Tom Sell.

Membership in the SWCA continues to grow according to SWCA Secretary/Treasurer Steve Verett. Verett reports that the latest addition to the South West Council's membership roster is the Lubbock Chamber of Commerce, which made its decision to join the group shortly



before the SWCA's inaugural membership meeting December 14, 2006.

TSSC conducts 2006 project review; sets timeline for 2008 project submissions

Cotton producers benefit in many ways from the Cotton Research and Promotion Program and the efforts of Cotton Incorporated. One of the most visible components of CI's research program is known as the State Support Program.

The Cotton Incorporated State Support Program provides cotton growers across the nation the ability to direct the expenditure of CI research dollars toward Key production and profitability challenges that they face on the farm.

In Texas, research funded through the State Support Program addresses issues such as cotton marketing and economics, cotton breeding, genetic improvement, insect management, irrigation and fertilization management, weed control, production systems, as well as harvesting and ginning issues effecting harvest efficiency and crop quality.

Project funding decisions are the responsibility of the Texas State Support Committee, which is composed of cotton producers from across the state.

In addition to determining what projects are funded, the committee also meets to receive progress reports on funded research.

This year's project review was conducted in Lubbock on December 12 and 13 as members of the committee, cotton producer organization representatives and researchers gathered to hear updates on the progress of research projects funded for the 2006 crop year. A total of 33 projects were reviewed during the two-day meeting.

While in Lubbock members of the Texas State Support Committee also finalized the timeline for soliciting proposals and approving projects for funding in 2008.

Each year the Texas State Support Committee receives projects in six broad research categories: genetic improvement, pest control, fertilization/irrigation, production systems, harvesting/ginning and marketing/economics.

For the 2007 crop year, the Texas State Support Committee has approved \$936,304 to fund 41 projects covering the full range of research areas.
