## The State Department of Highways and Public Transporta. ion has come out with an interesting and colorful folde ritled "Texas Rocks and Fossils."

 It documents a surprising number of mineral andthat aré found in substantial quantities in the state.
The folder divides the state into seven regions, e Scurry County sits near the line separating the High Plains and North Central Texas regions, both rich in minerals and
gem stones, according to the accompanying lists. However, the
best bets for collecting interesting rocks on the High Plains are along the Caprock and in the Palo Duro Canyon area, accerding
to the information in the folder.
The North Central Texas region has the biggest variety. Its
area begins just suth of Bie Spring, veers southeast to include area begins just south of Big Spring, veers southeast to include
San Angelo and northeast to cover the area roughly from
scurry County to Weatherford and north to the Oklahoma line It has fossils dating back 300 million years, several varieties of
