# Kirks to go on Mission field

A love of children and of Christ is leading a Floydada couple, Kenney and Terri Kirk, to sell their home and hit the mission field.

The Kirks, who have been married for 33 years, are starting a whole new chapter in their life as husband and wife.

An ordained Methodist preacher, Kenney took a leave of absence in 1993 to go back to school and get a secondary education degree. "I wanted to work with at-risk kids," said Kenney.

The couple moved to Floydada in 1995 and Kenney took a job to teach at the alternative school (AEP), and Terri taught at the Parent Adolescent Center for 7 years.

Terri also taught pre-school at Kids Korner for 3 years.

"I knew God was calling me in a new direction," said Kenney. "For the last 3 1/2 years I've been doing computer work waiting for the next step."

The next step for the Kirks has turned out to be working in Youth With a Mission (Y-WAM).

Y-WAM is no ordinary ministry. The training is intense and requires very dedicated mission minded workers.

To be involved in Y-WAM the Kirks must first attend the University of the Nations in Kona, Hawaii, where they will undergo training.

The U of N offers training for people involved in cross-cultural work and/or Christian ministry through studies in Arts, Christian Ministries, Communications, Counseling and Health Care, Education, Humanities & International Studies, and Science and Technology.

The university combines traditional classroom learning with a discipleship atmosphere and practical mission-field experience.

"Everyone who works with Y-WAM must go to U of N," said Kenney. "First we will attend Discipleship Training Schools (DTS) for 11-12 weeks."

"We will live on campus in a dorm room," said Terri. "We will

be paired up with a team where we will learn to work together and worship together, etc. The teams are made up of people from all over the world. We know we will be with a team that will include a 22 year old Korean and a family from Switzerland. Our team will range in ages from 17 years to 50 years."

"While at U of N you study in different fields that will be useful on the mission field," said Kenney.

"There is pre-med, engineering, education, arts, etc. Then the teams are sent out into the mission field as something besides missionaries. There are many places that won't let you in as a missionary or evangelist, but they will let you in to teach, or build something, or take care of the sick. While you are there taking care of that need then you share the gospel of Jesus Christ.

"It can be very dangerous in some parts," said Kenney.

After DTS the teams are given field assignments for 7-9 weeks.

"We believe we will be going somewhere in the Middle East," said Kenney. "Possibly Syria, Afghanistan, Jordan, Israel, or Egypt."

"The Christian missions are already there and we go hook up with them. We work with established churches to get in the door."

Kenney and Terri say their contribution to the team will be in youth ministry. "I may be teaching English," said Terri. "And I may be putting on street dramas," said Kenney.

Kenney says he knows one place he definitely won't be going.

"I can't go to Saudia Arabia," said Kenney. "I am considered persona non grata there since I converted a Saudi pilot to Christianity. He is also under the death penalty there and can't go back. He came from a very wealthy family and he had to give up everything."

The Kirks will leave Floydada December 22 to visit family for Christmas. They will then leave

for school on December 29th and come back to Texas May 26, 2006.

The Kirks are looking forward to their new adventure even though parts of the decision have been personally hard.

"We had to sell our home," said Terri. "We had to downsize from a 4 bedroom home to a 1 bedroom duplex apartment in Brownfield. (The Kirks have moved their belongings to a duplex next to Terri's mother).

"My mother has Alzhiemers and it is hard to leave all her care to my sister right now. It will also be hard to leave our sons."

"We consider Floydada our home," said Kenney. "We have been members of First United Methodist Church for 10 years.

Floydada has given a lot to us. We wouldn't be doing what we are doing now without them. We will be back."

Kenney and Terri say they are excited to continue their work with young people. "My favorite role is that of a counselor," said Kenney.

"We've always been involved with young people," said Terri. "Children have been my ministry."

Deliveries will begin at about 11:00 a.m., Christmas Eve.

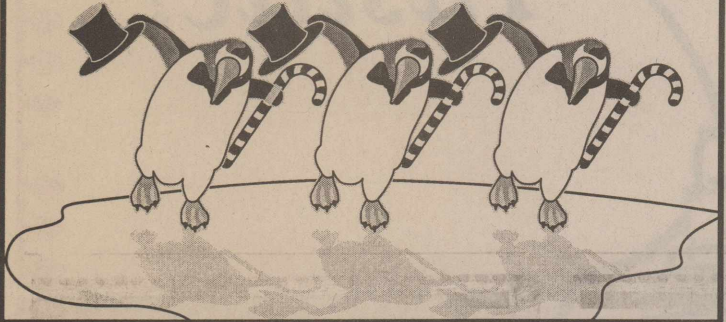
Volunteers will gather on the 23rd at the First United Methodist Church to de-bone turkey and prepare other dishes.

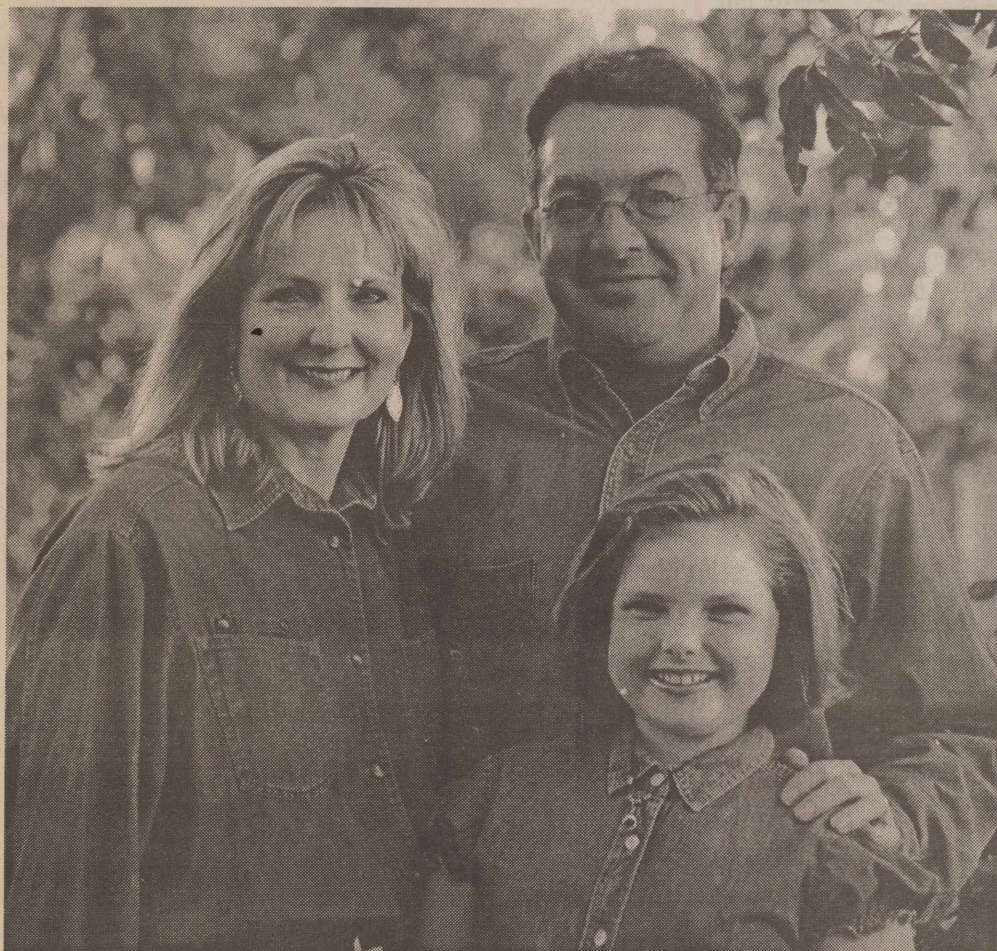

# Caprock Cellular asking for permission to build tower

During the Lockney City Council meeting on Thursday, December 15, 2005, Mayor Rodger Stapp informed the council a site had been chosen for the new Caprock Cellular phone tower. It will be located on the railroad property between Northeast Second street and North Main on the east side of the street.

"This tower will make cellular phone service much better in this general area, which is now considered a problem reception area because of the distance to existing towers," said Mayor Stapp. The agenda item concerning the lease of this property for the tower was tabled due to not receiving the lease contract yet.

A discussion concerning investing the city's money and getting the best interest possible ensued. However, the agenda item concerning an amendment to the City Investment Policy was tabled until City Attorney Lanny Voss could do further research into the legalities involved.

The Council discussed and agreed to begin the process for tearing down two more dilapidated houses in town.

In other business, Bil Anderson

gave the LEDC quarterly report. According to Anderson, the Leadership Lockney continues with 16 participants who meet the second Wednesday of each month. He mentioned the LEDC continues to use Jean Shotts on a time basis as needed for EDC advice. For quick answers they periodically ask Karen Houchin in Floydada.

LEDC members are currently as follows: Bil Anderson, President; Preston Belt, Vice-President; Kelly Prayor, Treasurer; Pat O'Connell, Secretary and new members, Phil Cotham, Jim Doucette and Kay Martin. "We have basically, an all new board of individuals, and we are interested in learning all we can to do the best job for Lockney,"

Anderson said. "Training and orientation for new LEDC members will continue as the opportunity presents itself. Primary training will be through SPAG."

"People want to live in a neighborly community. We need more neighborly actions. In this regard, I want to commend Vida Hrbacek for giving a neighborhood block party," Anderson stated. "I hope more people will

become involved in hosting block parties."

"The LEDC is taking steps to determine the direction to take in terms of realistic expectations for our city. Toward that end a SWOT analysis will be undertaken over several meetings. In these meetings Lockney's Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats (SWOT) will be identified and used to determine our direction and areas of emphasis," Anderson continued. "It is likely that the LEDC's direction will heavily involve agriculture."

Anderson brought up the subject of getting a written statement from the Council showing positive support for new businesses the LEDC contacts as an encouragement for them to locate here. Lanny Voss suggested the Council and the LEDC board meet to hammer out the language of such a statement, then add it to the agenda of a future City Council meeting for adoption. All agreed.

"I want to recognize the members of the original LEDC board for the foundation they laid for us to build on," said Anderson. They really got the ball rolling and their hard work deserves our

recognition."

Kelly Prayor presented the quarterly financial report which showed income for the 4th quarter at \$15,420.47, expense at \$1,686.16, for a net income of \$13,734.31. She also presented the LEDC's 2006 proposed budget projecting revenues of \$26,780.00 and expenditures of 26,300.00 for an excess of revenues over expenditures of \$480.00.

Michael DeLeon made the motion to accept the LEDC report, Junior Brotherton voiced a second and it passed unanimously.

Board members Bil Anderson, Kelly Prayor and Kay Martin were present.

Lindan Morris addressed the Council and informed them he wants to put up a metal fence, "I feel it is necessary for resident's properties around my business to be able to retain their value." Mayor Stapp asked Morris to develop a written plan including specifics, then request to be added to the next agenda where he could present it and ask for a variance.

In other business, the Coun-

cil considered the Roy Ray properties which have been in violation of City Code for three years. Council members agreed to pursue the process already set in motion and follow through to the end.

Routine agenda items were considered and passed unanimously.

City Administrator Ron Hall announced the placement of the City trailer by the municipal water tower on Locust Street for the purpose of disposing of natural Christmas trees, and only those trees. "The trailer will remain there for one week following Christmas day, for the convenience of our Lockney citizens," Hall added.

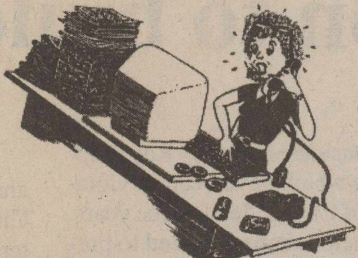

# Chamber thanks Commissioners

The Floyd County Commissioners met Monday, December 12, and heard a 'thank you' speech from Floydada Chamber of Commerce Manager Rachael Castillo.

Castillo said, "I want to thank you, the commissioners' court, for all your help and cooperation with this year's 'Dickens of a Christmas'. The court house looks beautiful. I drive by at night and the windows look so pretty with the candles in them. I want to thank you for the other two trees (on the court house lawn). I told my children this is history and when their children grow up, they will remember when the trees were planted. I can't say thank you enough."

In other matters, the commissioners gave unanimous approval to County Judge William D. Hardin to sign a new agreement requested by the Attorney General of Texas to redirect and process all child support payments established prior to January 1, 1994.

## Caprock Hospital District approves purchase of radios

The Caprock Hospital District Board of Directors met Tuesday, December 20, and approved the purchase of two more radios, with accessories, for the EMS paramedics, according to Board Member Tom Farris.

In a related matter, newly appointed EMS Director Katrina Gooch reported 64 runs by the EMS during the month of November. "This is above average," said Farris.

The board approved a request by the Floyd County Central Appraisal District office to allow the appraisal district to keep the hospital district's share of a \$4,733 budget surplus found in their 2004-2005 audit.

Indigent health care of \$45.95 was approved to be paid by the board.

The PNS Clinic update showed a \$25,508.11 profit in November, according to Farris.

Present for the board meeting were Board President Rex Lawson, Board Members Tom Farris, Kyle Smith and J. Royce Bradshaw, EMS Director Katrina Gooch, PNS Cogdell Clinic Office Manager Maybelle Monreal and PNS Representative Paul Acreman.

Judge Hardin said, "This will direct all child support payments, established before 1994, to the Attorney General's office, and not to us here. This will lighten our work load. I recommend it."

A new Capitalization Inventory Policy was also approved by the court. This involves eliminating any item under \$5,000, and over three years old, from being placed on the court house yearly inventory list.

The commissioners approved a request by the City of Floydada to tear down an old house and clean the lots of county property located at 416 W. Lee Street, Lots 11 & 12, Blk 24, of Original Town.

The official bond for Justice of Peace Michelle Araujo, of Pcts. 2 and 3, was unanimously approved by the commissioners.

Four farm contracts were approved by the commissioners.

They were: located two miles north of Cedar Hill to reclaim a cattle pit by J.C. Welch; located 12 miles northeast of Floydada to clean out an earthen stock tank by Travis Jones; located at 2750

on FM 1958 to dig a pit and bury improvements by Jason Pyle; and located on Becker-Hegi Farms to build up a turn row by Magie Hegi of Petersburg.

The court reappointed Commissioner Ray Nell Bearden to another two year term to represent Floyd County on the Floyd County Appraisal District Board

of Directors.

The court transferred \$28,000 from the Road and Bridge Fund into the four precincts at \$7,000 each to be used for general expenses.

Floyd County Treasurer Elva Martinez gave a written Financial Report to the commissioners. The November, 2005 report showed a Beginning Balance of \$822,376.15, with Receipts of \$397,402.50. The report gave Transfer In and Out at \$385,293.22, with Disbursed at \$290,087.15, leaving an Ending Balance of \$929,691.50.

Producers have been concerned for months that the Bush Administration's trade team, led by U.S. Trade Representative Rob Portman, might be headed to Hong Kong ready to sacrifice the U.S. cotton program to appease our international critics.

After the opening rounds of the WTO ministerial meeting were conducted earlier this week, some of those fears may begin to recede thanks to some strong statements by the U.S. Trade Ambassador.

Unfortunately, much of the good will that was created by those words could be tempered by a seemingly one-sided offer to allow African cotton into the U.S. duty and quota free.

The question to ask may be what is the U.S. really offering these countries. The majority of African Lesser Developed Countries (LDC) already have at least some level of duty free/quota free access for cotton products through the African Growth and Opportunity Act (AGOA).

Because of AGOA, it seems that the primary benefit to African LDC's from the U.S. offer would be the world's other major cotton purchasers, namely China and India, following the U.S. lead and opening their own markets to West African cotton. How those countries will react to

the U.S. proposal is unknown.

There is simply no way to know how the U.S. proposal will eventually play out inside the much bigger chess game of the WTO negotiation process. To guess at its impact now would amount to little more than use-less speculation.

Despite concern over the African duty free/quota free offer, Ambassador Portman has also gotten high marks from U.S. cotton industry observers present in Hong Kong.

Especially heartening to the U.S. contingent were Ambassador Portman's comments during the opening cotton/banana plenary meeting at which he and USDA Secretary Mike Johanns were present.

Speaking last, Portman provided a strongly worded statement after representatives for African, European Union, Brazil and other countries had made comments that mostly focused on the moral aspects of the cotton issue and ignored economic factors affecting the situation completely.

Portman's response to these arguments rebutted the concept of separating cotton from the overall agricultural negotiation process. Portman said before cotton issues can be resolved the broader scope of agriculture is-

sues should be addressed.

Portman pointed out that several economic studies, including one from the International Monetary Fund, show that the complete elimination of U.S. cotton programs would only affect a 2 percent change in world cotton prices.

The U.S. cotton industry has repeatedly noted that the IMP study and studies from other respected international organizations confirm that ending U.S. cotton subsidies will not significantly change the outlook for African cotton farmers.

The National Cotton Council reiterated this point in a letter to Ambassador Portman thanking him for his statements at the cotton plenary meeting.

The NCC noted that his comments were appropriate and that the industry appreciated his strong commitment to achieve a comprehensive agreement that benefits a majority of farmers and to deflect efforts seeking a separate resolution for cotton.

The NCC also praised Ambassador Portman's acknowledgment that the African problem is bigger than the subsidy issue and that any effort to address cotton that ignores the other issues does not provide African cotton farmers the representation they need.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FLOYDADA, TEXAS PROHIBITING THE USE OF THE HERBICIDE 2, 4-DICHLOROPHOXYACETIC ACID (COMMONLY KNOWN AS 2, 4-D) AND ITS DERIVATIVES, (INCLUDE PARENT ACID AS WELL AS SALT, AMINE AND ESTER DERIVATIVES) WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF FLOYDADA, BETWEEN THE MONTHS OF MARCH AND NOVEMBER, BEGINNING MARCH 1 OF EACH SPRING AND ENDING NOVEMBER 10 OF EACH YEAR; PROVIDING A PENALTY OF NOT LESS THAN FIFTY (\$50.00) DOLLARS NOR MORE THAN TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) FOR VIOLATIONS; PROVIDING THAT EACH DAY VIOLATIONS ARE PERMITTED TO EXIST CONSTITUTE A SEPARATE OFFENSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Floydada City Council desires to eliminate the use of herbicides and landscape maintenance products that can adversely affect human and environmental health; and

WHEREAS, all reasonable steps should be taken to maintain the health of our community in a sustainable manner, to the benefit of all residents and future generations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Floydada understands that the landscape infrastructure of the City and private property can be maintained in a thriving and sustainable manner without causing environmental and human harm;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Floydada as follows:

1.01 Herbicide 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic Acid and its derivatives: the Prohibition of Use on Parks, Open Space Parcels, and Public Rights of Way and Private Property, Including Both Aerial Spraying and Ground Applications of the Herbicide 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic Acid (commonly known as 2, 4-D) and its derivatives (include parent acid as well as salt, amine and ester derivatives) within the City limits of the City of Floydada between the months of March and November, beginning March 1 of each spring and ending November 10 of each year.

1.02. Purpose: The use of the herbicide 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic Acid (commonly known as 2, 4-D) and its derivatives (include parent acid as well as salt, amine and ester derivatives) is of such great concern to the City Council that in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of Floydada residents and its environment this ordinance is being adopted.

1.03. Definition: For purposes herein, herbicide 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic Acid (commonly known as 2, 4-D) and its derivatives (include parent acid as well as salt, amine and ester derivatives): shall mean any spray adjuvant, foam, liquid, solid or substance or mixture of substances, which is intended to be used for defoliating plants, regulating plant growth or for preventing, and/or destroying vegetation detrimental to desired vegetation, man, animals, fish, other aquatic life or households, between the months of March and November, beginning March 1 of each spring and ending November 10 of each year.

Use. The use of Herbicide 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic Acid (commonly known as 2, 4-D) and its derivatives (include parent acid as well as salt, amine and ester derivatives) is strictly prohibited within the City limits of the City of Floydada between the months of March and November, beginning March 1 of each spring and ending November 10 of each year. The "use" shall be defined as both aerial and ground spraying, including spraying, dusting and any wet application method or any other ground application methods, including but not limited to aerial and ground equipment, such as knapsack sprayers, pressure and hose-end applicators, and lawn spreaders.

1.05. Penalties. Any person, firm, or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be a penalty of not less than fifty (\$50.00) dollars nor more than two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) for violations; providing that each day violations are permitted to exist constitute a separate offense.

1.06. Severability. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance hereby approved are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not effect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation of any unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

1.07. Repeat of Conflicting Ordinances. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed

This Ordinance as approved shall take effect upon completion of publication as provided by law. The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to cause the publication of the descriptive caption hereof together with the civil and criminal penalty provisions for violation thereof

WHEREAS, ROBBY GREEN, hereinafter called the Petitioner, has petitioned the City of Floydada, Texas to close public alleys and streets to Block Six (6), Ten (10), Eleven (11) and Twelve (12), Starks Addition, an addition to the Town of Floydada, Floyd County, Texas, as shown in plat of said Starks Addition recorded in Vol. 26, page 19, Deed Records of Floyd County, Texas, and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Floydada has found and determined that the Petitioner is the owner of all lands abutting such public streets and alleys; that the existence of such public streets and alleys serve neither public nor private necessity or convenience; and

**Tract 1:** Third Street is closed from a point beginning 59.9 feet North of the Southeast corner of Lot 5, Block 6, to the Northeast corner of Lot 16, in Block 7, then East across Third Street to a found 3/8" road for the Northernmost point of Block 11, then South along the West line of Block 10, across Taft Street to a point 59.9 feet North of the Southwest corner of Lot 6, in Block 12, then West to the point of beginning, all in Starks Addition to Town of Floydada, Floyd County, Texas.

**Tract 2:** Taft Street is closed from the Southwest corner of Lot 14, in Block 7, then South 30 feet to a 5/8" rod being the Northwest corner of Lot 1, in Block 6, then East along the North side of Blocks 6 crossing Third Street continuing along the North boundary of Block 12, to a 3/8" rod being the Northeast corner of Lot 4, in Block 12, then in a Northeasterly direction to the Southeastern corner of Block 11, then West along the South boundary of Block 11, crossing Third Street and continuing along the South boundary line of Lots 16, 15 and 14 in Block 7 to the point of beginning, all in Starks Addition to Town of Floydada, Floyd County, Texas.

Beverly passed away Sunday, December 11, 2005 at the Cleveland Medical Center Hospital.

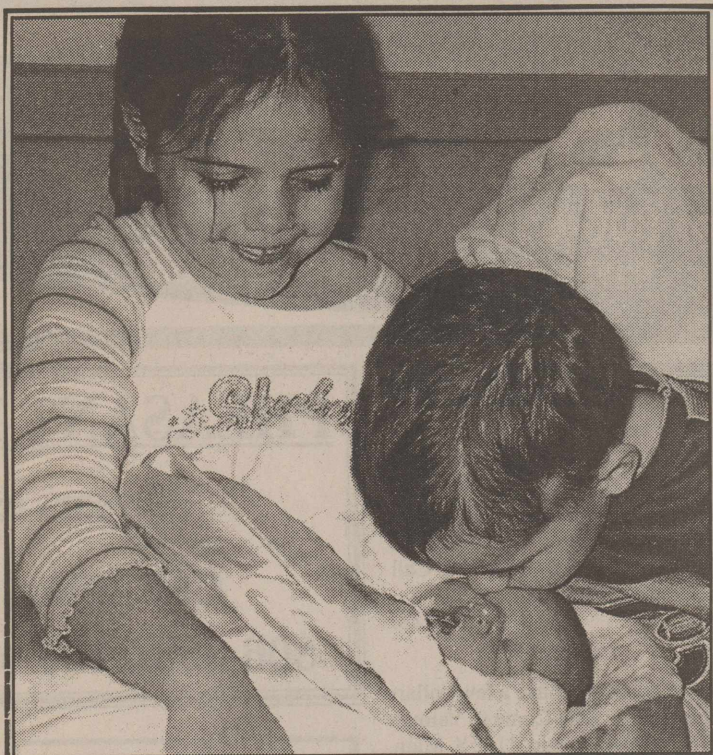
She was born July 8, 1948 in Plainview to Clifford Hallowell and Helen Martin.
