Ordinance No. 152 Regulating Speed Of Trains

An Ordinance
Entitled an ordinance regulating the speed of electric,
gasoline motor and steam loco motives or trains within the City limits of the City of Strat
ford, Texas: Providing penalty for the violation hereof, and repealing
contrary hereto contrary hereto.
Be it ordained by the City
Council of Stratford, Texas: Section 1. That it shall hereafter be unlawful for any engineer or other person in charge of any electric, gasoline motor or steam locomotive or train to
run the same within the cor porate limits of the City oor Stratford, Texas, at a greater rate of speed than
(35) miles per hour. Section 2. Any engineer other person in charge of any electric, gasoline motor or steam locomotive or train violating
any of the provisions of this orany of the provisions of this or-
dinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof in the corporation court of the City of Stratford, Texas, shall be fine
in any sum not more than on hundred ( $\$ 100.00$ ) dollars. Section 3. All ordinances or
parts of ordinances in conflict parewith are hereby expressly herewiln
repealed.
