Attention All Producers of Groundwater in the North Plains Groundwater Conservation District

Your 2017 production reports are due
in the Dumas office by 5 pm on
Thursday, March 1st.

The 2017 Annual Production Reports for the North Plains Groundwater Conservation District are required to be completed and filed in the District Office no later than March 1, 2018 by 5:00 PM. Each report filed after March 1, 2018 will be subject to a \$50.00 per day late filing fee up to \$500.00 per report. Reports deemed "LATE" are not eligible to accumulate Groundwater Conservation Reserve. Reports sent in by regular mail and postmarked on or before March 1, 2018 will be considered on time. To accommodate filing, the District Office will be open from 8 am - 5pm including the 12- 1pm lunch hour from February 26th to March 1st. There is an after-hours drop box for reports located next to the front (East side) entrance. Any mitigating circumstances that would prevent the producer from reporting on time, should be reported to the District Office as soon as possible and will be evaluated by the General Manager on a case by case basis. The board and staff thank you in advance for your cooperation and support of the management of the area's groundwater resources.

Time is here once again for Sherman County Soil and Water Conservation District's annual Spring Tree Sale. Order forms are ready and can be picked up at our office - 418 North 4th in Stratford.

While we try to list as many species that are available for this area, we cannot list them all. If you have any special wants or wishes as far as trees go this year, please call the office and we will be happy to try and find what you need.

The District can also fill requests for drip irrigation supplies. We keep some drip supplies in stock, and will help in the design of your system and order exactly what is needed for you if we do not have it. Delivery is usually within three working days. You can also help your investment with the installation of weed barrier. We have this available also. This is especially important in windbreaks because we do not want the newly planted seedlings to have to fight with weeds and grass for water. The barrier will help prevent the growth of weeds and grass and keep the moisture in the ground.

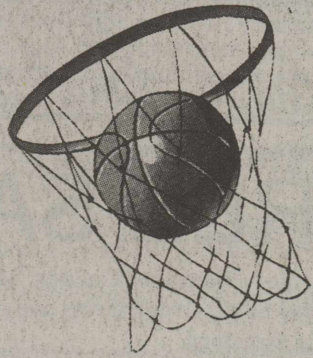

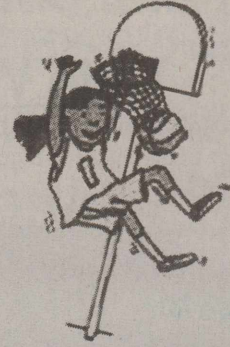

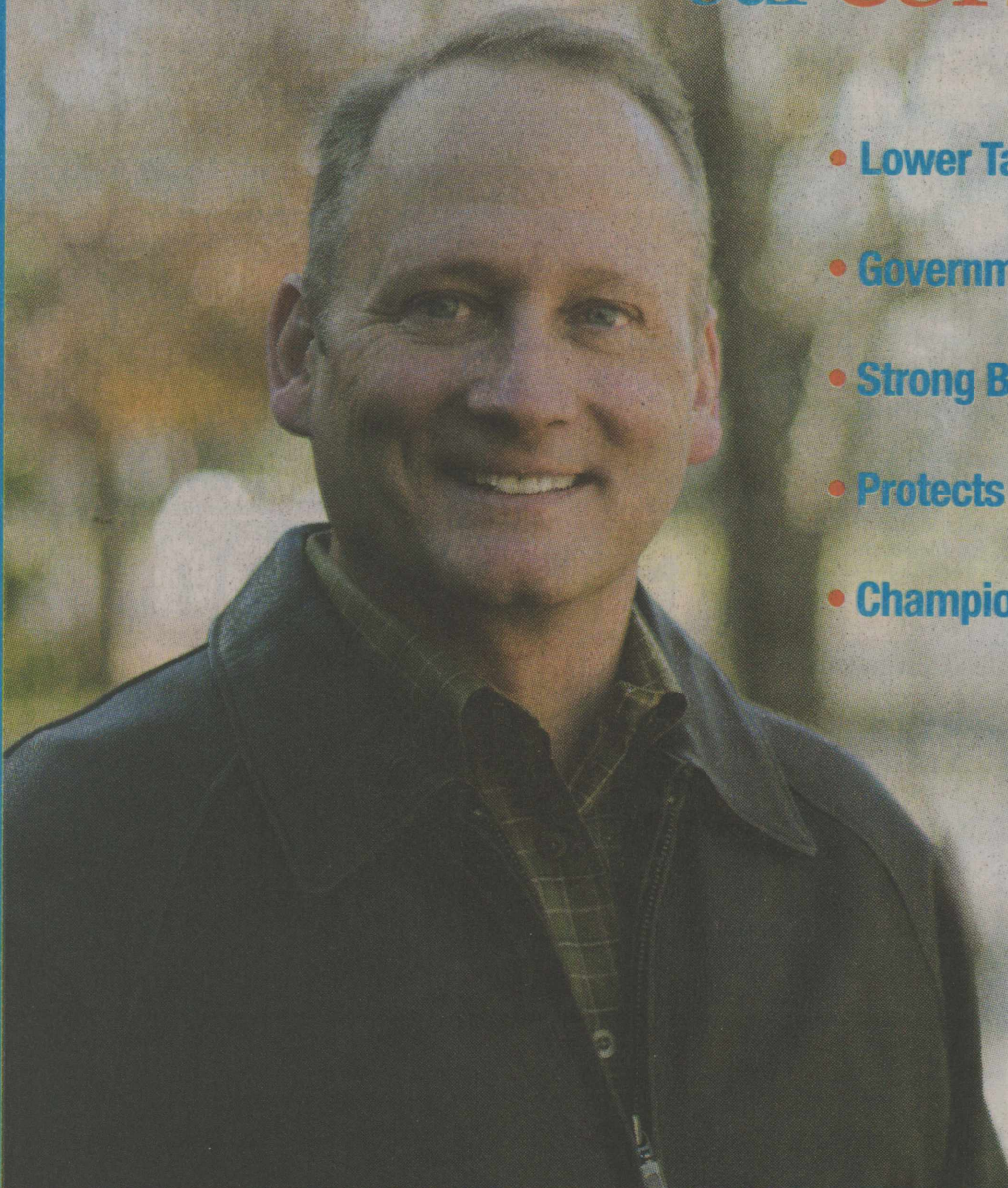
