Memorial Hospice has proudly served terminally ill patients within Moore, Hartley, Dallam, and Sherman counties for the last 15 years.



Your Growth Through the Bible

A little gal we knew was not growing properly. Her legs were too short! A certain doctor took a look at her and immediately knew the problem. It was a heart problem! Adequate blood was not getting to her legs. Improper physical growth was evidence of this physical heart. In the same way, improper spiritual growth is evidence of a spiritual problem. You see, growth is an absolutely necessary part of the Christian life! The Biblical word referring to growth is sanctification. But if the Holy Spirit does not live in you, you are not a Christian! The Bible is clear, "If anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him" (Romans 8:0). How does growth come about? Listen to the apostle Paul, "I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified" (Acts 20:32). When Paul speaks about the word of God, he means the Scriptures of the Bible! Other books may claim to be Scripture. Only the Word of God in the Bible is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance of heaven! So this coming year, if you want to grow, you need to read the Bible! Read five or six pages every day and you can read through the Bible in a year!

Elks Advance to Play-offs


