from the National Aeronatics and Space Administration's Langely Research Center in Hampton, Va.,
went to the Oklahoma center to conduct tests to termine how lightning affects aircraft in flight. The best way to a ccomplish the objectives, of course,
is to get lightning to hit an aircraft with people in it. So, that is exactly what they did
After two fruitless weeks, the pilot was startled by he team's first lightning strike.
"We were inside a cloud, with visibility about 152 meters ( 500 feet). There was heavy rain and moderate
