## Groundwater <br> Transportation Issue By Richard Bowers General Manager NPGCD

There has been a lot of
concern recently in regard to concern recently in regard to from the northern Panhandle of Texas to other areas of the Panhandle and throughout the
state. The first time this iss surfaced to any lame this issue when the Canadian River Municipal Water District (CRMWD) requested a permit Conservation District (PGCD) which ended in an agreement between the two entities. The City of Amarillo has been using Carson County well field located in PGCD since the late 50's. They also have negotiated with PGCD for a change in their
transportation permit With the lat 30
Within the last 30 days local and national news media have
publicized stories about the purchase, transportation and sale of groundwater from the
Panhandle of Texas, by private Panhandle of Texas, by private
corporations, to cities as far south as Fort Worth and San Antonio. what has amazed me is how surprised everyone seem to be in
regard to this possibility regard to this possibility. I can't
remember how old I was when I first heard that water would be more valuable than oil. That day
may soon be here and it appears may soon be here and it appears
that the oil companies are that the oil companies are
realizing that groundwater is a transportable and marketable product.
At the time the groundwater
districts were formed in the districts were formed in the
Panhandle of Texas, one of the concerns was that our water (groundwater) would be pumped rom our area to other areas of the state. Perhaps a groundwater
district could prevent this from happening. Texas groundwater law, in my opinion, has never provided a groundwater district with the authority to prohibit the
ransportation of groundwater within the district or exported out of the district. Texas groundwater law has allowed the district the
right to regulate the production of the groundwater. This gives the Cont. on page 5

The 'rule of capture" applies in a groundwater district. Simply, it means that a person (entity) has the right to capture and use the water beneath the surface. This is When a groundwater district is created and confirmed by a vote of the people, the district then has the Texas Water Code to regulate the groundwater within the Private ownership groundwater applies throughout
the state and basically means that groundwater is a privately held resource and may be used, sold, purchased and transported by the
owner or entity having a right to owner or entity having a right to
the resource. This may be through a sale, lease or other contracts. It is understood that unless the groundwater has been separated
from the surface it belongs to the from che surface it belongs to the
surface owner. Many cities in he Panhandle area have purchased groundwater (groundwater rights)
from surface landowners. These from surface landowners. These
cities have the "right" to produce cities have the "right" to produce
the groundwater. If the the groundwater. If
groundwater is within groundwater district, the rules of the district will govern that
production of the groundwater. production of the groundwate Groundwater Conservation District do limit the production of groundwater. We limit the total
gallons which may produced from gallons which may produced from
a section of land. This limit is currently 5 gallons per minute per acre (Rule 9). In addition to Rule 9 , we address "overproduction" of
groundwater in Rule groundwater in
Depletion. This
Depletion rule allows the District to restrict the production from any well within
the District that is the District that is depleting the
groundwater at a rate greater than groundwater at a rate greater than
the "allowable decline rate" as determined by the Board. The current allowable decline rate is 1 $1 / 4$ percent of the saturated
thickness. At this time our Rules do not address transporation of groundwater.
The issue of individuals or
