Several comments were made in surprise that Stratford was not growing with a location on two major highways and two major rail lines. All I could say was I am surprised too. It has only been available about 60 years or

The things I see to improve services are of course to remove the bottleneck at the highwayrailroad crossroads, but also an area for a larger truck stop and a RV Park. Stratford needs the infusion of outside money as the busineeses here, including farming and ranching, are struggling to put money back into their business. Do we have a positive attitude to attract outside money?

Stratford could be distribution point for rail to truck products. We may be too little too late as there are several along US 54 and US 287.

What you know is more comfortable even if it could be improved. Change results are unknown and are scary. I think about the change since the 1950's with businesses and services cut in half. Some of those changes we had no control over, but some we did.

We need some creative thinking and planning to take advantage of opportunities.
