"The cost of heating a home these days can be stag gering. Yet some people still don't seem to realize that without proper insulation much of the heat they're paying good money for is wasted Heat rises, so the first place to stop it from escaping is the attic floor of your home.

Buy insulation by " $R$ " value, not thickness. "Different materials have different insulating properties. Four inches of one type of insulation might do the same job as six inches of another. So find out what "R" value is recommended for homes in your area and buy with that in mind. Your local gas company can help you and give you information about the different types of insulation as well.

Ventilation is important, too. "Ironically, the heat that once escaped to your attic may have helped keep it dry. So to keep moisture from condensing and causing problems in a newly insulated attic, be sure to provide enough ventilation for air circulation

You can install insulation yourself. "Insulating most attic floors can be as simple as laying down batts of insulation between the rafters. (Be sure to put the vapor barrier on th
