## Stratford Band Students <br> Receive High Ratings At UIL Solo/Ensemble Contest

On Friday, February 7, 53 Stratford Band students traveled to Canyon and the Canyon High School campus to perform in the UIL Region 11 Instrumental Solo/ Ensemble Contest. Of 24 separate events entered, Stratford received 21 Division I (Superior) Ratings. This
