Stratford - Agricultural leaders from Sherman County Farm Bureau attended the 83rd, Texas Farm Bureau Annual Meeting Dec. 3-5 in San Antonio.

Attending from Stratford were Jimmy & Ineta Chesher. Discussion of the latest agricultural issues, including high speed rail, eminent domain, property rights and property ag valuation; the recognition of top county Farm Bureaus and individuals; and evaluation of the organizations policies, were the tasks for more than 900 voting delegates from 159 organized county Farm Bureaus.

County delegates voted on proposed policy changes during the meeting's business session the final day of the meeting. Farm Bureau policies reflect the needs of local faimers and ranchers and direct the state's largest farm organization. Approved recommendations on national policies advance to the American Farm

Bureau Federation annual meeting to be held in January in Phoenix, Ariz.


Materials prohibited in brown containers-The following shall not be disposed of in city's brown containers: hazardous waste, liquid waste, used motor oil, used oil filters, lead acid batteries, yard waste (grass clippings, leaves, yard/garden debris, brush), construction/demolition/remodeling debris, lumber, shingles/roofing material, chairs/furniture, mattresses/box springs, waste tires (automotive/implement/truck/tractor), major appliances/fixtures, and dead animals.

Sec. 13.04.041 Dirt, concrete and rocks prohibited in containers

The disposal of dirt, concrete, and rocks in city trash containers is hereby prohibited. (Ordinance 970519, sec. 9, adopted 5/19/97)

Construction materials and shingles must be disposed by the company doing the work. Please inform any contractor that they are not to use the city dumpsters to dispose of any construction material/waste. The city does not accept shingles, batteries, tires or concrete in our dumpsters or at the landfill at any time.






