This is the shortest of the three
phases. The phases. The uncontrolled
discharge of tension build in the first phase. The trigger for his violent outburst is usually his own internal reaction to an external
event. Physical assaults and event. Physical assaults and
destructiveness characterize this phase.
When the actual attack is over, it is followed by a period of shock,
denial and disbelief. Many victims report reactions similar to those of disaster victims, suffering emotional collapse. She will probably lie to her family and or police or refuse to press charge against him.
PHASE THREE: The Honeymoon Phase. Just as phase two is
characterized by characterized by brutality, phase
three is characterized by extremely kind, loving and contrite behavior of the abuser. He may realize his behavior got out of hand and try
to make it up to his victim. In this phase, the batterer behaves in
charming and loving manner.
