On a recent trip to Austin, abundant amount of information concerning the available resources stopped by to talk to Santa and have some refreshments. offered through the state. Several guarantied, loans, or grants are available as incentives through the State of Texas. Some examples of these programs are as follows: Rural Economic Development Fund, Texas Capital Fund, Texas Exporters Loan Commercialization Fund, Product Development Fund, and Small Business Incubator Fund.

### Cancer Screening Rescheduled

The Breast Cancer Screening Program of the Don & Sybil outreach clinics for early detection of breast cancer.

cancer is the major goal of cancer control for each woman seen in the clinic. The clinic provides low cost screening which includes a breast exam by a Registered Nurse trained in breast cancer

Currently, the most effective method known to win the battle against breast cancer is early detection. Early detection is best done by following the guidelines recommended by the American Cancer Society for breast cancer screening for women who have no signs or symptoms of breast cancer. The guidelines are:

1. Learn & perform breast self examination every month.

2. Have a physical examination every year.

3. Have a mammogram according to the recommendations by age.
