## Tornadoes

Much has been written about the devastation caused by recent tornadoes in the Midwest and South, but relatively
little about minimizing danger incase one of these intense, cyclonic funnels approaches one's home.
There are some things one can do in minutes. All win-
dows should be opened. This sometimes prevents houses dows should be opened. This sometimes prevents houses
from exploding-which is what often happens in a tornado from exploding-which is what often happens in a tornado,
since the swirling suction-like pressure sucks up all air,
greatly reducing barometric pressure inside the small funnel, often only a few hundred feet across. When this funnel descends on a home or moves over it,
the pressure indoors, if windows and doors are closed, bethe pressure indoors, if windows and doors are closed, be-
comes so much greater than outside, walls are literally blown - outward. Of course, the tornado's swirling winds are often moving at one or two hundred miles an hour. A strongly built
house will usually stand against hundred-mile gusts, even stronger winds.
