## Granting Credit Under the Quarter System

der a semester system one unit courses will be offered for ( 160 clock hours) fee quarters. One-half unit courses under a semester system will be offered for her one quarter or two quarters under the quarter system. Some (one-half unit) ourses will be reduced from 80 to 60 clock hours of instruction while others will Increased from 80 to approximately 120 clock hours of instruction. Decisions hcerning which courses are offered for one or two quarters will be made after ch course is examined individually. Courses for high school will be granted follows:

Eudents may meet the graduation requirements with $1 / 2$ semester unit or 2 varter units in American Government. Students who accumulate units under oth systems shall recompute their total number of semester units into quarter nits by multiplying the cumulative units of credit by three. In the event that student has a half unit of credit in his cumulative semester units, the half it shall be rounded to the next quarter unit

nder the quärter system, one-half credit courses such as electives are to come quarter courses. Schools may operate beginning and advanced courses they elect to do so and grant quarter credits for each course.
