1 egg 1 tablespoon Worcestershire

11/2 teaspoons salt 11/2 teaspoons monosodium

glutamate 1/4 to I teaspoon oregano

16-ounce package sliced

1/4 teaspoon pepper

Mozzarella cheese Combine all ingredients except cheese; mix thoroughly. Divide meat mixture in thirds. 1/3 in botton of 91/2x5x3-inch loaf pan; cover with half of cheese. Repeat layers, ending with meat. Bake in moderate oven (350°) 1 hour. Makes 5 or 6 servings.
