## Municipal Sales Tax Questions \& Answers

Q. What items are subject to the $\mathbf{1 \%}$ municipal sales tax?
A. The $1 \%$ city sales tax is applicable only to those sales now taxed under the State Sales \& Use Tax Act.
Q. There is a $\mathbf{2 \%}$ State tax on automobiles. Would the eity sales tax also apply to automobile sales?
A. No. The $\mathbf{2 \%}$ State tax on automobiles is an excise tax: the municipal sales tax would not apply to automobile sales.
Q. Does the city sales tax apply to sales at wholesale?
A. No, only to retail sales. Goods sold for resale are not taxable.
Q. Are city sales tax payments deductible on our Federal income tax reports?
A. Yes.
Q. Does the municipal sales tak apply to purchases by units of government (couny, state, other cities, etc.?
A. No, all are exempt.
Q. Does a persoh residing outside the city limits pay the $1 \%$ munieipal sales tax
A. Yes, when he makes a purchase of personal property subject to the tax in city which has adopted the local sales tax. In return, he onjoys the eity's streets, fa cilities, police protection and other advantages of the city for which eity dents pay the major share.
Q. Assuming that City " $A$ " has the sales tax and City " $B$ " does not, and a sale is made in " $A$ " but delivery is to be made in "B", " $A$ " colleet the tas?
A. Yes. The sales tax is levied at the POINT OF SALE.
Q. If merchandite is ordered from a mail order bualness in City " $A$ ", which has the ocal sales tax, for delivery in City "B", which also has the tax, which city is eligible to collect on the sale?
A. City "A" collects, since it is the point of sale, rather than delivery.
Q. What are some of the items which are exempt from the $\mathbf{1 \%}$ city sales tax?
A. Among many other exempt titems are ineluded cigaretteb, cigars, automobile water, telephene and telegraph, meals served by hospitals to patients, meals sold y a church, food products which are not prepared for eating, prescription medines and prescription oyegiasses, cement, alcoholic beverages (umless includd on meais), gasoiline, farm machinery and products which will be used in the anufacture or another product which is not subject to this tak.
A complete list of exempt items is available from the State Comptroller, Aus-
Q Who can vote on the $1 \%$ local sales tax?
A. Any registered voter in the city. A simple majority is required to put the sales tax into effect.
