





#### Warning Issued On Defoliating Cotton Too Soon

A warning note against defoliat ing cotton too early is sounded Citing the recommendations of the state experiment station, Jason Gordon, for 12 years on the Ex-tension Service staff, and now farm supply firm member, says foliants not be used until cotton is per cent open.

The reason is that if the leaves of the plant are killed the fiber will not mature fully. Fifteen days, in general, are needed in this area, said Gordon, to harden the fiber of the cotton and completely mature it.


