## HOW FARMERS UNION FEELS ABOUT DRIVERS OF FARM TRANSPORTATII

EXEMPTION OF DRIVERS OF SMALL FARM TRUCKS ing drivers under 21 years of age provided they meet requirey state laws and regulations, was requested March 22 , by
Farmers Union President Tony Dechant. In a letter to Seels of Transportation John Volpe, he asked that drivers of tam under 10,000 lbs. gross weight be permanently exempt from farm. Regulations removing such exemption are scheduled to effect July 1. In addition, Dechant urged that agriculture bo a local haul exemption comparable to the commercial
in urban areas. The exemption would be applicable in circumstances: (1) When trucks are used to transpor marketing or to another farm; and (2) When trucks are witu products acquired for farm consumption or production purpaw
