

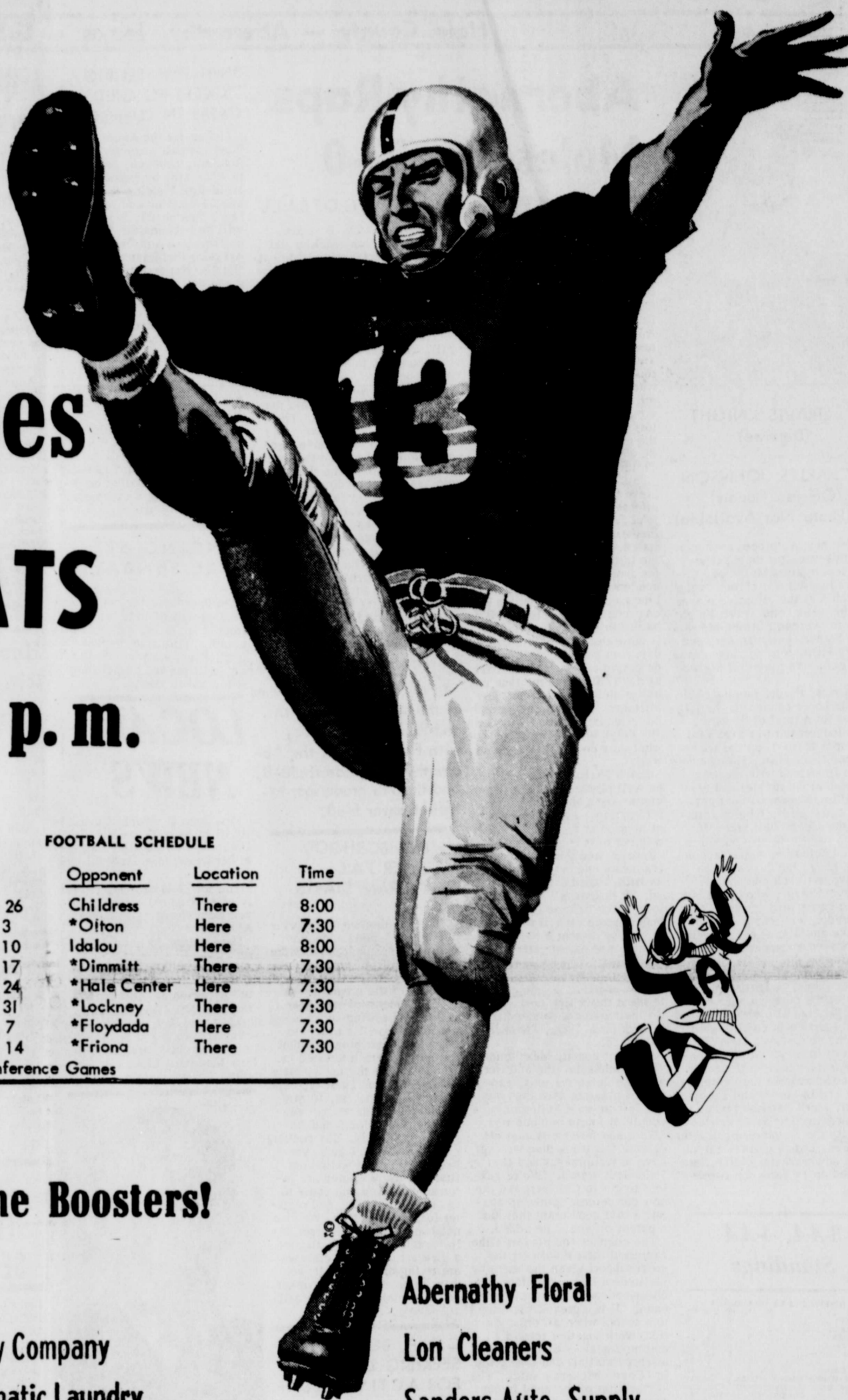

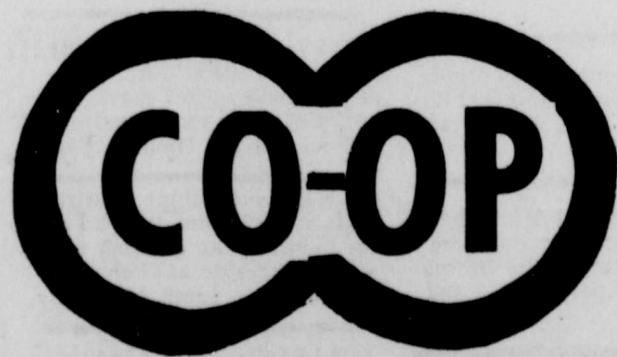

### LETTER TO THE EDITOR

As ex-residents of Abernathy we thought you might be interested in a few items about us. We have just transplanted ourselves in California here at the University of California at Berkeley. Our address is 812 Riley Drive, Albany, Calif. 94706. Phone 415-525-4351.

Prior to moving, I was at Texas Tech. Although I didn't receive my degree (M.S. in Ag. Eco. with a minor in Mathematics) until August, I was on the Tech Staff during the summer working on an economic "input-output" Study of the State of Texas under contract with the Governors Office.

While enrolled in Tech, I was on a Research Assistantship and in the Spring of '69 I was also awarded an Ag Eco Fellowship. My thesis topic was "System Analysis Approach to the Selection of Farm Equipment". I wrote a computer program which will select a least cost set of farm machinery (tractors & implements) for a specified farm situation. (Incidentally, I had a 4.0 grade point average in my Graduate Work at Tech.)

As you may remember, after a three year hitch in the Army (part of which was spent in New Jersey- we have now lived on both the Atlantic & Pacific Coast) I returned to Tech and was graduated with a B.S. in 1966. From June 1966 til February 1968 we were in Belton, Texas where I was with the Agricultural Extension Service.

We received considerable ribbing from acquaintances because of our projected move to the Berkeley area - the home of the "Hippies". However, local tell us that there are signs this movement is on the decline, or at least, is going elsewhere although, to us, it is still very much in evidence. (These movements are not new - In the 1820's & 30's similar groups with almost identical patterns of behaviour, slogan, moral "belief", dress or lack of it, hair styles, bathing habits - the whole works - were common.) It does appear that these people and other radicals have damaged the university system in California particularly in funding - more than I had anticipated.
