} sales cannot realistically expect higher prices for their wheat in 1973, a spokesman for National Farmers Union has cautioned.

Weldon Barton, NFU Assistant Legislative Director, voiced the concern about lower prie
the Sumner County Farmers Union,

Barton stated two reasons why "next year" may never come for wheat producers in early-harvest states, in the sense of continuation of higher prices into the 1973 marketing year.

First, the Nixoa Administration is already encouraging a larger U. S. Wheat crop for next year. After displaying virtually no abinty to predict the huge Soviet sales weeks after they were made), the USbA is saying to wheat producers that the Soviet Union prow ably will have to import large quantities of grain gext year to meet its commitment for improving Russlan diets by 1975 .
"This speculation," Barton said, "flies in the face of tausties indicating that during 1950-1972, any poor whett much larger crop the next year. The USDA's speeute. tion is reckless, and appears designed to pretuce an un realistiely-large U. S. crop and lower prices in 1973. To understand the low-price disaster into which this kind of speculation can lead the producer, one need only leok at the way (and the reasons) to sell CCC stocks entil the price is driven down around \(115 \%\) of the loan rate, or a. oul present price levels.
