Ordinance Number 187

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING PUBLIC NECESSITY FOR THE IMPROVEMENTS OF CERTAIN DESIGNATED PORTIONS OF CERTAIN DESIGNATED STREETS IN THE CITY OF ABERNATHY, TEXAS; SPECIFYING THE NATURE AND TYPE OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT; ESTABLISHING THE MANNER OF EFFECTUATION AND METHOD OF PROCEDURE THEREOF, DESIGNATING AND SEPARATING UNITS OF WORK; ALLOCATING DIVISION OF PAYMENT OF COST; PROVIDING RULE FOR APPORTIONMENT OF COST; FIXING TIME, TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PAYMENT OF COST AND PROVIDING AND DEFINING ASSESSMENTS THEREFOR; SPECIFYING NATURE OF ASSESSMENT LIENS AND PERSONAL LIABILITY; PROVIDING FOR ISSUANCE AND PROVISIONS OF ASSIGNABLE CERTIFICATES IN EVIDENCE OF ASSESSMENT FOR COSTS; AND DIRECTING THE CITY ENGINEER TO PREPARE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF DESIGNATED UNITS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABERNATHY, TEXAS:

1.

That public necessity exists and requires that the following portions of the designated streets in the City of Abernathy, Texas, should be improved, as herein provided, to-wit:

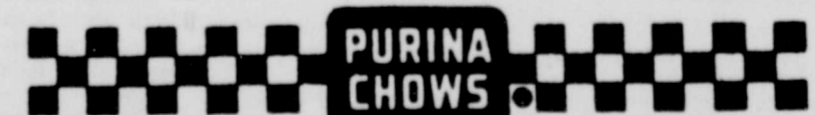
