## Grandmother's Pot-Roast Buttermilk Gravy

3 to 4 -pound beef $1 / 2$ cup buttermilk blade pet-roast 6 medium carrots, cut 1 tablespoon dry mus- 1 in 2 -inch piackes ( 10 ounces) tard frozen Brussels 11/2 Teaspoons Salt $\begin{array}{ll}1 / 2 & \text { Teaspoons Salt } \\ 1 / 4 \text { teaspoon cooking fat } & \text { Broussels or } 1 \text { pound }\end{array}$ 1 beef bouillon cube 1 cup buttermilk $1 / 3$ cup hot water Flour for gravy Mix flour, mustard, salt and pepper; dredge Dutch oven. dissolve in water, add to meat, cover tightly and dissolve in water, add to meat, cover tightly and
cook slowly $11 / 2$ hours. Add $1 / 2$ cup buttermilk and carrots and continue cooking, covered, 30 minutes. Add Brussels sprouts and continue cooking, covered, 30 minutes or until meat and vegetables are tender. Remove meat and vegetables to warm platter. Blend 1 cup buttermilk with flour and use to thicken cooking liquid for gravy.
