**SEEDS FROM THE SOWER**

A merchant said to a deacon, "I like your new preacher." "How can you say that?" he asked. "You've never heard him preach." "No, I haven't," he admitted. "But he must be good. Your church members are beginning to pay their bills." When people really get right with God they will get right with man. You cannot be right with God if you are wrong with man. 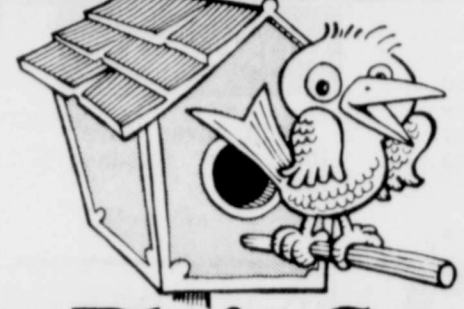

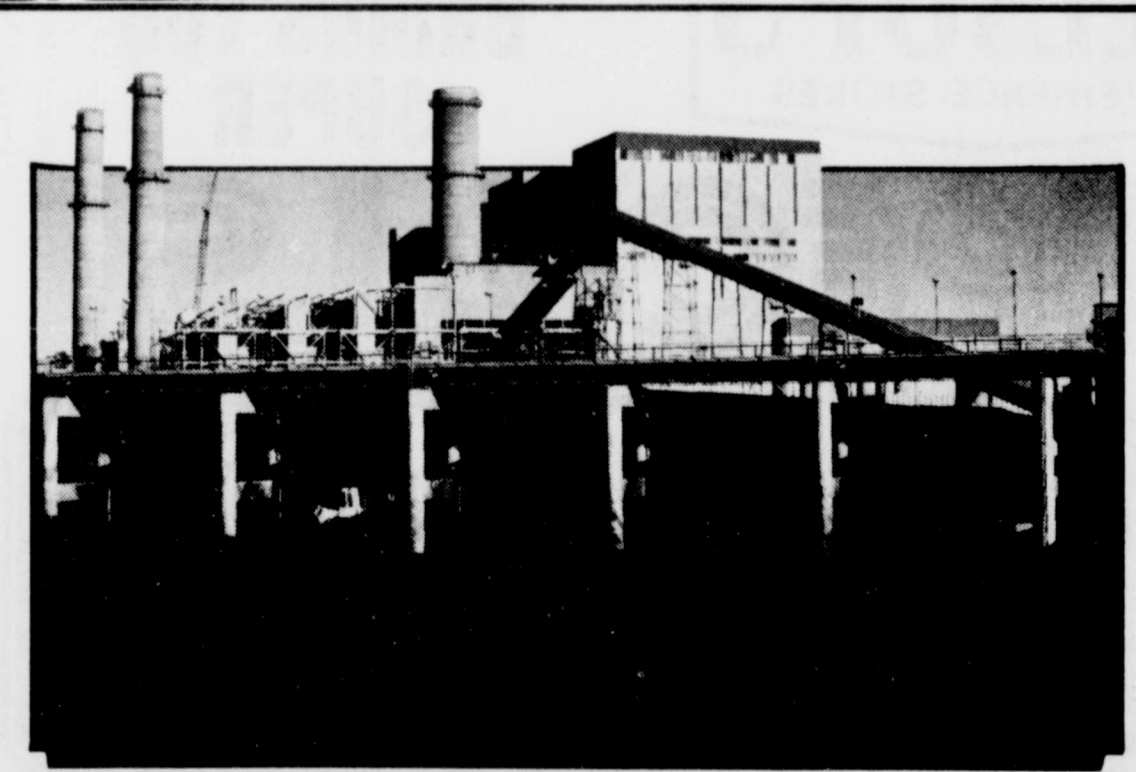

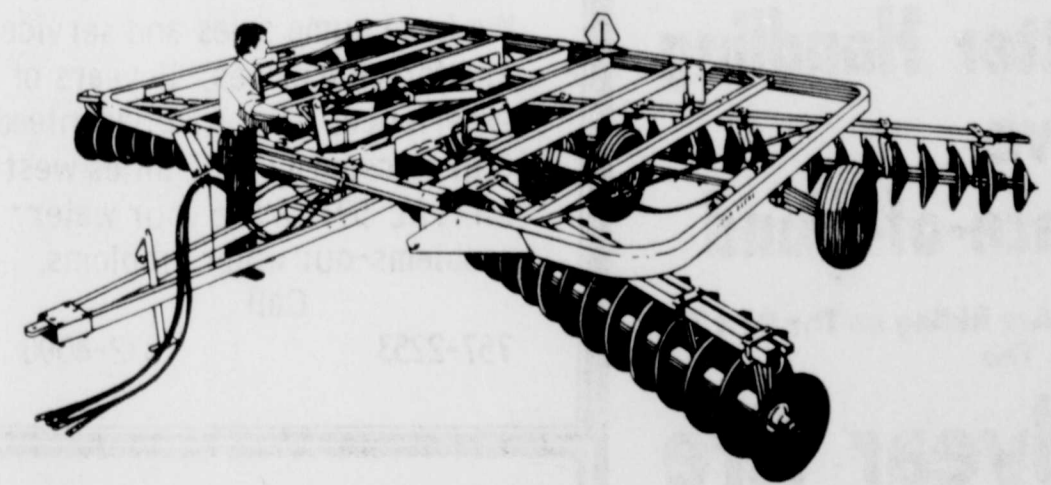
